HYT provides consistent, high-quality opportunities for youth to actively participate in theater throughout the year. We are dedicated to helping children build social connections, gain confidence, and develop their talents through meaningful artistic experiences. In addition to our annual spring production, we offer week-long summer camps that give students hands-on training in acting, music, and performance. During the school year, participants gather for weekly Friday rehearsals at Peteetneet, creating a consistent space for skill-building, collaboration, and creativity. We also foster strong community involvement by engaging families, volunteers, and a parent board in each production. This collaborative environment strengthens connections within Payson City and helps create a culture where the arts are shared, supported, and celebrated.
Describe how the requested PARC funds will be used.	The requested funds would be used to purchase a storage trailer. Because we do not have dedicated storage at Peteetneet, production materials such as set pieces, props, costumes, and technical equipment can be difficult to store and transport. A trailer would provide a secure, mobile storage solution, allowing us to stay organized and efficiently move materials between rehearsals and performances. It would also reduce clutter in shared spaces at Peteetneet, keeping the facility accessible for other community groups.
