Agenda Item	Welcome & Introductions/Establish Quorum
Notes	Sandi Johnson welcomed the Committee. Sandi Johnson established that a quorum was present.
Agenda Item	Approve Minutes from February 2, 2026 Meeting
Notes	Sandi Johnson inquired if everyone had a chance to review the minutes from the previous meeting. Motion : Sheriff Mike Smith made a motion to approve the minutes from the March 2, 2026 meeting. Scott Sweat seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.
Agenda Item	Review of Complaints
Notes	<p>1. H.P Complaint</p> <p>The Committee discussed H.P.'s complaint dated 03.09.2026. This is the third complaint against the Utah County Attorney's Office (UCAO) that H.P. has filed. The underlying criminal case involves Dr. David Broadbent and has been ongoing for approximately three years. The complaint alleges two violations of victims' rights: the right to timely notice of judicial proceedings they are to attend and timely notice of the cancellation of any proceedings and the right to a speedy disposition of the entire criminal justice process.. The Committee reviewed the court docket and H.P.'s complaint form regarding a pretrial conference originally set for March 2, then rescheduled for March 9, 2026. H.P. was notified that the hearing would take place on Monday, March 9 at 5:20 pm on Friday, March 6. On Monday, March 9, H.P. called the attorney's office in the morning and was told the hearing was still proceeding. After checking the online docket and calling again, H.P. was informed it had been cancelled. The court docket shows the March 9 hearing may have been scheduled as early as January 28, yet the victim was not notified of the specific Monday date until the preceding Friday evening. The committee noted that they addressed a speedy disposition violation at the meeting in March, and did not feel there were additional facts in the complaint to address the violation again at this time, although it is related to the facts in this complaint.</p> <p>Motion: Sandi Johnson motioned to find a potential violation of H.P.'s rights to timely notice of judicial proceedings but no violation of the right to a speed disposition of the entire criminal justice system. Scott Sweat seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.</p> <p>Action Items: Sandi Johnson will draft letters to H.P. and the Utah County Attorney's Office inviting them to the next meeting and requesting additional information.. Katie Fox will send the letters and coordinate their attendance.</p>
