Stacey said that she called the customers and let them know the \$50 was put toward their water bill.
- Yvonne is wondering if there was ever anything done about the construction company that wanted to buy water for the Morrison Mine clean up project. Stacey says that Mayor Cox was in charge of that and he was going to talk to the company to see if they have done anything about it.
