ROLES & RESPONSIBILITIES

A TEAM EFFORT TO SECURE FUNDING AND DELIVER RESULTS FOR OUR COMMUNITY.



GRANTS ADMINISTRATOR

Identify grant opportunities, manage applications, coordinate across departments, and ensure compliance and reporting.



DEPARTMENT LEADS

Define project scope and needs, provide technical information, support implementation, and track progress.



FINANCE DEPARTMENT

Confirm budget availability, manage grant accounts, track expenditures, and ensure fiscal compliance.



CITY ADMINISTRATION

Review priorities, ensure alignment with City goals and the Capital Facilities Plan, and provide overall oversight.



CITY COUNCIL

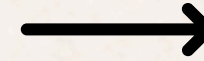
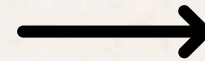
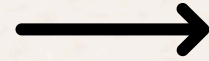
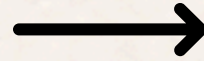
Approve funding and policy, support grant applications, and authorize agreements and accept awards.



PARTNERS / CONSULTANTS

Provide specialized expertise, planning support, or grant writing assistance as needed.

THE GRANT PROCESS



IDENTIFY OPPORTUNITIES

Grant Admin and Dept. Heads research and identify grants that align with City goals and needs

EVALUATE & PLAN

Review eligibility requirements, and alignment with the Capital Facilities Plan and budget.

APPLY

Grant Admin Prepares and submits competitive, high-quality applications.

AWARDED

If selected, we negotiate terms, and execute agreements.

MANAGE & REPORT

Administer the grant responsibly and report results.

OUR GUIDING PRINCIPLES



ALIGNMENT

Grants must align with city priorities and the Capital Facilities Plan



FISCAL RESPONSIBILITY

We only apply for grants for projects that have appropriated local match and resources.



COMMUNITY IMPACT

We pursue grants that provide meaningful, measurable benefits for our residents.



LEVERAGE

We maximize outside dollars to stretch taxpayer investments further.

BUDGET & PLANNING CONNECTION



WE CAN ONLY APPLY FOR GRANTS FOR FUNDS THAT WE HAVE APPROPRIATED DURING BUDGET SEASON.



WE USE THE CAPITAL FACILITIES PLAN (CFP) AS OUR ROADMAP WHEN IDENTIFYING AND APPLYING FOR GRANT OPPORTUNITIES.

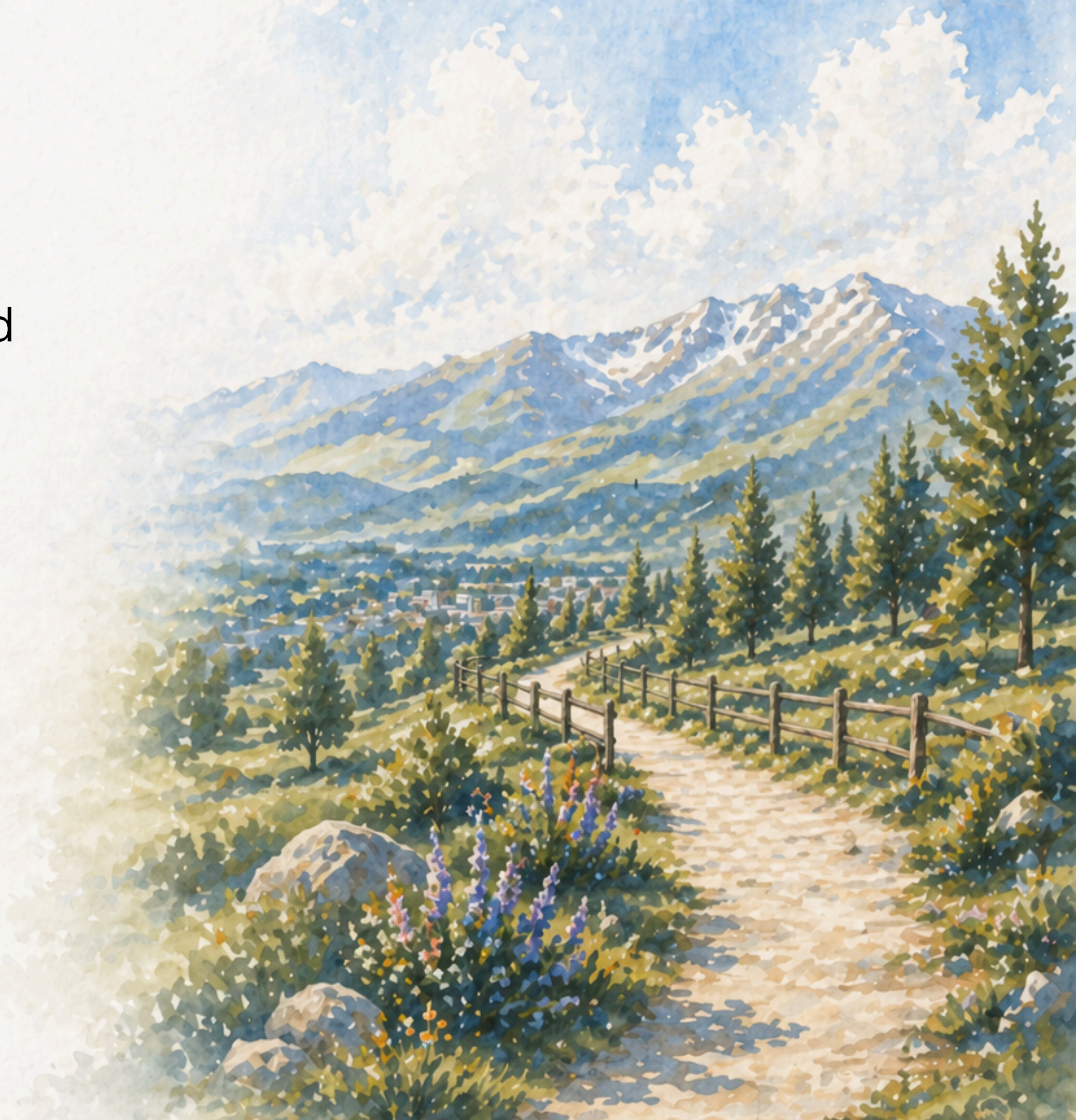
