Purpose of Memo:

Result of legislative action

Background:

This policy is proposed in accordance with **Utah Administrative Rule R277-615**, which requires LEAs to adopt written policies and procedures for student searches. The draft establishes a two-part "reasonableness" test, requiring that any search be justified at its inception and reasonable in scope relative to the student's age, sex, and disability or communication needs. Furthermore, it fulfills the rule's mandate for specialized communication access during searches and provides clear protocols for the confiscation and disposal of electronic cigarette products.
