The Southeastern Utah Association of Local Governments dba Southeastern Regional Development Agency Second CDBG public hearing was held on Monday, May 04, 2026 in the SERDA Building at 252 S. Fairgrounds Road, Price, Utah 84501 at 12:00 PM.

### **COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) PUBLIC HEARING:**

Jade Powell opened the second public hearing for the CDBG program. Jade Powell stated that this hearing was called to allow all citizens to provide input concerning the project(s) that was awarded under the 2026 Community Development Block Grant Program. The Southeastern Utah Association of Local Governments dba Southeastern Regional Development Agency has amended its capital investment plan and decided to apply for funds on behalf of the Weatherization Program, Admin and Planning Project, Regional Planning Project, and Single Family Housing Rehab Project in the service areas of Carbon, Emery, Grand and San Juan Counties. Jade Powell introduced Korrin Olson from the Southeastern Utah Association of Local Governments dba Southeastern Regional Development Agency as the program manager. Jade Powell explained that the application was successful in the regional rating and ranking process and each of the projects were awarded the following: \$50,000 for Admin and Planning, \$50,000 for Regional Planning and \$174,000 for Single Family Housing Rehab. Jade Powell explained that the application for SEUALG's weatherization program was deemed ineligible at the time of rating and ranking and later reinstated as an eligible project. Due to the misinformation, SEUALG decided to not pursue the award for the weatherization program this program year.. Jade Powell asked for any comments, questions and concerns from the audience. Jade Powell shared the location of the meeting and then introduced himself as Deputy Director, Chris Allred introduced himself as Community Impact Director and Cort Probst introduced himself as Workforce Development Specialist. Jade Powell indicated that the public hearing would remain open for approximately 15 minutes to allow for any public comments to be heard. There were no comments made and the hearing was adjourned at 12:20 PM.
