Meeting Minutes

March 5, 2026

1. Roll Call: Leland Roberts, Ray Dixo, Jimmy Thomas, Troy Johansen, Francisco Escabar, Brian Sagers. Staff: Corey Bullock, Amy Rice
2. Troy motioned to approve the minutes. Brian seconded. All in favor. Minutes approved.
3. Committee Member Reports: Jimmy has been running the trails all winter. Francisco has been exploring trails throughout the county. He is wondering how he knows which land throughout the county is accessible to the public. Leland expressed concern about people accessing the Skyline Trail. He said a Jeep was driving on it this winter. Leland also discussed creating more gravel bike trails.
4. Director Update: Corey stated that the county has adopted Class B roads, which will allow the trails map to be updated. The map will be reviewed by multiple parties before publication. The Diamondback trail plan was submitted again. The BLM hired an employee to fill the vacant trails position. Corey hopes to begin construction on the trail this year. The High Desert Trail is under NEPA review across the state. The Middle Canyon trail is designed. Corey has applied for a few grants to build the trail.
5. Public concerns and comments: J Braun stated that the current trail map is out of date. He feels that Sheep Rock Mountains signage is inadequate. Corey let J know that Sheep Rock Mountain is under the jurisdiction of the BLM and the Forest Service.
