RESOLUTION 2026-03

A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE LAKETOWN CONSOLIDATED FEE SCHEDULE; AMENDING THE FEES TO BE CHARGED FOR THE USE OR RENTAL OF THE RODEO ARENA; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, §10-3-717 of Utah State Code (as amended) allows the Town Council to exercise all administrative powers by resolution including the establishing of water and sewer rates; establishing charges for garbage collection and fees charged for municipal services; establishing personnel policies and guidelines; and regulating the use and operation of municipal property; and

WHEREAS, the Town charges various fees which are collected by the Town Clerk to offset the expense of providing certain municipal services, including those pertaining to the use and rental of Town facilities such as the rodeo arena; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council has determined that large events held at the rodeo arena with anticipated event attendance over one thousand (1,000) individuals impose greater costs on the Town for facility wear, cleanup, traffic management, public safety coordination, and administrative oversight than smaller-scale rentals; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council has determined that the amendment of established fees as set forth in the Laketown Consolidated Fee Schedule is required to cover the associated costs incurred to the Town for providing such services to its residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Council of Laketown, Utah:

SECTION 1: Amendment. The Parks And Recreation section of the Laketown Consolidated Fee Schedule is hereby amended to read as follows:

PARKS AND RECREATION:

PEAK SEASON RACE EVENTS	\$500.00 (Non-refundable, per event) <i>(NOTE: Memorial Weekend - Labor Day.)</i>
OFF PEAK SEASON RACE EVENTS	\$250.00 (Non-refundable, per event)
PARK & ARENA RENTAL <u>(UNDER 500+000 ANTICIPATED EVENT ATTENDANCE)</u>	\$150.00 per day (Plus a refundable deposit of \$1,000.00 which will be returned if Town property/facilities are left clean and neand undamaged.)
<u>PARK & ARENA RENTAL (500 and over OVER 1,000 ANTICIPATED EVENT ATTENDANCE)</u>	<u>\$4,500.00 per day (Plus a refundable deposit of \$1,000.00 which will be returned if Town property/facilities are left clean and undamaged.)</u> <u><i>(NOTE: A Special Event Agreement (i.e., contract) with the Town of Laketown is required.)</i></u>

SECTION 2: Severability. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase of this amendment is declared invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, said portion shall be severed and such declaration shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this amendment.

SECTION 3: Effective Date. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage and the fees set forth herein shall become effective on May 6, 2026.
