REQUEST FOR QUALIFICATIONS AND STATEMENT OF INTEREST For Community Medical and Dental Service Providers

Daggett County, Utah, is soliciting qualifications and statements of interest from qualified medical and dental providers to provide onsite services in Daggett County using the New Daggett County Health, Business and Community Center which is scheduled to open July 2026. To meet the deadline for the initial approval, all responses to this RFQ must be received electronically or in person by 5:00 PM (MST) on May 26, 2026. All vendors intending to submit a response are requested to submit a (1) Statement of Interest and (2) Qualifications, along with any questions they may have. All questions from all vendors will be consolidated and answered in writing by 5:00 PM (MST) on May 29, 2026. Vendors will review the information posted and communicate any requested changes or updates in writing by the final response deadline of 5:00 PM (MST) on June 5, 2026.

All Statements of Interest must include:

1. Company name and address.
2. Statement explaining interest in providing services.
3. Brief History and description of company.
4. Number of medical providers providing services to include:
 - a. Licenses and qualifications for each provider.
 - b. Years of experience for each provider.
 - c. Related experience providing medical services in a rural community.
5. At least one reference from a governmental entity in a community where the company currently provides services.
6. Scope of Services to include:
 - a. Proposed days and hours per week of operation.
 - b. Office equipment and supplies to be provided by provider.
 - c. Office equipment and supplies to be provided by County.
 - d. Medical equipment and supplies to be provided by provider.
 - e. Medical equipment and supplies to be provided by County.
 - f. Projected number of annual clinic visits.
 - g. A description of supplementary services intended for short-term implementation (e.g. physical therapy, diagnostic imaging, specialist telemedicine etc.)
 - h. A strategic plan for the long-term expansion of medical services.

8. Projected annual operating expenses.
9. Provider's Expectations.

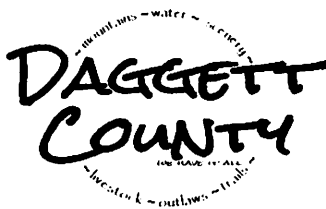

County Information:

Daggett County is the least populated County in Utah, with approximately 935 year-round residents. The area is a recreation and agricultural paradise with beautiful red rock canyons, lakes, rivers, and forests. It is home to Flaming Gorge Reservoir, the Green River, and the Uintah Mountains. For these reasons, the population during the Summer and Fall can be as high as 15,000 to 20,000. The County's economy is based primarily on: Recreation and Tourism, Agriculture, Government work, and Natural Gas Extraction and Storage.

Clinic Statistical Information:

The new Daggett County Health, Business and Community Center is an 18,000 square foot facility constructed to support and enhance the physical, mental, and social well-being of our community. The center encompasses a 3,100 square foot Medical Clinic (including 2,210 square feet of dedicated space), an 80-person conference room, a mental health provider, an environmental health provider, Tele-pharmacy Space and designated areas for a dentist, a physical therapist, exercise facilities, and various meeting spaces.
