Dan Fechner, Jones & DeMille.

He sent a draft copy of the Transportation Plan to Recorder Bigler for distribution and review. Mayor Jenkins asked if he wanted to be on the agenda for the next Work Meeting. He will get back to him. Work is underway on the Booster Station project. He updated the Design Standards after meeting with the Planning Commission. He believes a follow-up with them would be a good idea.

Sheriff Doug Anderson.

He presented his retirement letter to the Mayor. He expressed his gratitude to the Mayor and Council for the opportunity to serve the community. His retirement will be considered a mid-term retirement. There was a discussion on how the Sheriff's department will run after he leaves.

Charles Davis – Recreation Committee Review of Quotes/Decision to purchase Wind Deflecting Hardware and Standard Hardware for light poles.

He wanted to get approval for a couple of quotes for the brackets and banners. They will also be changing all the hardware. Council Member Nedreberg made a motion to approve the quotes. Council Member Atherley seconded the motion. A roll call vote was taken all in favor motion carried.
