2026 Primary Election Information

I, Seth Marsing, Clerk of Carbon County, State of Utah do hereby certify that the attached is a sample ballot for the Primary Election held in all voting precincts on the 23rd day June, 2026, during the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. You are qualified to vote if you are a citizen of the United States, have been a resident of Utah at least 30 days immediately before the election, will be at least 18 years old on the day of the election, and currently live in the voting precinct where you have applied to register to vote. **There is only a Republican ballot for this primary election.**

The deadline to change party affiliation was April 1, 2026. (UCA 20A-2-107) This deadline does not apply to new or unaffiliated voters. Ballots will be mailed from June 2 through June 16, 2026. Ballots returned by mail must be in the possession of the Clerk's office by 8:00 p.m. on June 23, 2026. **In person Early Voting will be held Tuesday, June 16 through Friday, June 19 from 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Primary Election Day is June 23, 2026.**
