NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN pursuant to Utah Code Title 17, Chapter 79, Section 204, that the Salt Lake County Planning Commission will hold a public hearing on Wednesday, June 10, 2026 at 8:30 AM at 2001 S. State Street, N1-110, Salt Lake City UT 84114. The purpose of this hearing is to receive public comment regarding a proposed amendment to Salt Lake County's Resource Management Plan ("Plan") to add chapters addressing renewable energy; critical minerals and rare earth elements; utility corridors; and pipelines and infrastructure.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the Salt Lake County Mountainous Planning District Planning Commission will hold a public hearing on Thursday, June 18, 2026 at 3:00 PM at 2001 S. State Street, N1-110, Salt Lake City UT 84114. The purpose of this hearing is to receive public comment regarding a proposed amendment to Salt Lake County's Resource Management Plan to add chapters addressing renewable energy; critical minerals and rare earth elements; utility corridors; and pipelines and infrastructure.

During the Public Hearing a summary of the Plan amendments will be presented, followed by public comments, discussion, and vote consideration for a recommendation by the Planning Commissions to the County Council. The Planning Commissions will act on the proposed resource management plan amendments after taking comments from the public during the public hearing. Public comments will be provided pursuant to the planning commissions' rules of conduct. Public comments will be limited to three minutes per person.
