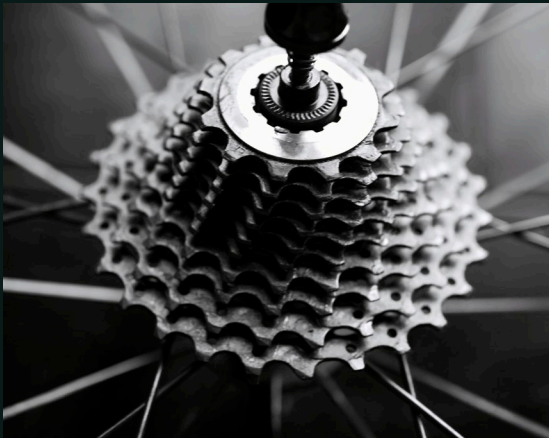

WILD ROSE TO BST CONNECTOR

- Working with USFS about alignment
- Utah Outdoor Recreation Infrastructure grant for design/construction (awarded \$15k – beginning 7/1/26)
- Next steps – ~~check in with Forest Service about alignment (use 2020 decision? Field visits likely needed)~~, hire trail designer/builder, flag trail on the ground with USFS, build trail, agreement with Davis County regarding maintenance, agreement with USFS/SLC/NSL about trail ownership

Safety Concerns @ Foxboro Wetlands Park



- The newly installed boardwalks at Foxboro Wetlands extend beyond the edges of the paved trails by several inches.
- The metal railings may impede the free and safe passage of cyclists when the full width of the trail is being shared and is therefore limited.
- Severe injury to the cyclist's hands is possible. Further complications may arise with resulting falls.



- A redesign of the railings, especially at the height of a cyclist's handlebar, is recommended.
