

A motion to go into closed session to discuss certain matters in closed session pursuant to the Utah Code annotated 52-4-5 was made.</p> <p>Motion to go to open session was made at 7:20 pm.</p> <p>The Council began the work meeting by reviewing the proposed Fiscal Year 2026–2027 Budget. Discussion was held regarding employee wages, during which Jack inquired about a salary increase for Amanda, noting that she had forfeited an increase the previous year. The Council also reviewed the Water Fund and discussed the need to monitor the utility fund closely. A water rate study will likely be conducted to help maintain the financial stability of the utility fund.</p> <p>The Council further discussed surplus equipment to be included in the July 24th auction. Items identified for auction included the old Massey Ferguson tractor, old Walker mower, and orange dump truck.</p> <p>Resident Shane Nelson stopped by to provide an update on the ball field project at the park.
