The Board was called to order by Chair Michelle Camp on May 12, 2026, at 9:00 a.m. in the Tuacahn Conference Room in the Taylorsville State Office Building located at 4315 S. 2700 W.

Adam moved to approve the last Board meeting minutes from February 24, 2026.

Jeremy seconded the motion, which passed unanimously. The minutes were approved.

All members were present except Rawlin Anderson, who was excused. A quorum of the Board was present. In the event of a tie vote, the decision of the Bureau will stand, as there would not be sufficient votes to overturn the Bureau's decision.

Agenda.....

Agent Steve Marshall was sworn in.

Merek Chertkow: The oath was printed out and given to Mr. Chertkow to read as he had difficulty hearing. After reading it, Mr. Chertkow agreed that he would abide by the oath. Agent Marshall read the disposition: On February 3, 2026, Mr. Chertkow's Utah concealed firearm permit was revoked based on a January 6, 1975, felony conviction involving the possession or manufacturing of a firebomb through the state of California. After the review of all the documents in the file and hearing Mr. Chertkow's testimony, Adam moved to uphold the revocation. Jared seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

Jiri Svrcek: Agent Marshall was reminded that he was still under oath. Agent Marshall read the disposition on behalf of Sgt. Zaugg: On October 29, 2025, Mr. Svrcek's Utah concealed firearm permit was denied based on a May 16, 2023, NLETS nationally denied person index stating, "you have stayed past your admitted date of September 15, 2024. After the review of all the documents in the file and hearing Mr. Svrcek's testimony, Adam moved to uphold the denial. Jared seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

9:43: Michelle moved to take a 10 minute break. All in favor.

9:59: Meeting reconvened.

Jesse Johansson (Absentia): Still under oath, Agent Marshall read the disposition, on behalf of Agent Vanderbeek: On January 26, 2026, Mr. Johansson's Utah concealed firearm permit was denied based on a June 14, 2022, conviction involving use or possession of drug paraphernalia, through the State of Utah. Jared moved to uphold the denial. Jeremy seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

Rodger Vancleave (absentia): Still under oath, Agent Marshall read the disposition: On March 17, 2026, Mr. Vancleave's Utah concealed firearm permit was denied based on a November 26, 2007, felony conviction involving possession of a controlled substance through the state of New Mexico. After reviewing all the documents in the file, Jeremy moved to uphold the denial. Adam seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

Michael Brogden (absentia): Still under oath, Agent Marshall advised the Board that the Bureau received additional information and has determined that it will reinstate Mr. Brogden's permit. No action was taken by the Board.

Luis Figueroa (absentia): Still under oath, Agent Marshall read the disposition: On March 7, 2026, Mr. Figueroa's Utah concealed firearm permit was denied based on a February 23, 1987, felony conviction involving grand larceny out of the state of New York. After reviewing all the documents in the file, Adam moved to uphold the denial. Jeremy seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

Brian Katz (absentia): Still under oath, Agent Marshall read the disposition on behalf of Sgt. Zaugg: On January 8, 2026, Mr. Katz's Utah concealed firearm permit was denied based on a July 12, 2022, class B misdemeanor DUI conviction, with a 3 year attached probation, out of the state of California. After reviewing all the documents in the file, Michelle moved to uphold the denial. Adam seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

John Bailey (absentia): Still under oath, Agent Marshall read the disposition on behalf of Sgt. Zaugg: On January 8, 2026, Mr. Bailey's Utah concealed firearm permit renewal was denied based on an April 29, 2025, pending felony charge involving falsifying business records out of the state of New York. After reviewing all the documents in the file, Michelle moved to uphold the denial. Jeremy seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

Patricia Washburn (absentia): Still under oath, Agent Marshall read the disposition on behalf of Sgt. Zaugg: On January 14, 2026, Ms. Washburn's Utah concealed firearm permit renewal was denied based on a March 6, 2025, misdemeanor B conviction of DUI out of the state of New York. After reviewing all the documents in the file, Michelle moved to uphold the denial. Adam seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

Joshua Martinez (absentia): Still under oath, Agent Marshall read the disposition on behalf of Sgt. Zaugg: On December 16, 2025, Mr. Martinez's Utah concealed firearm permit was denied based on a March 10, 2004, felony conviction involving criminal possession of stolen property out of the state of New York. After reviewing all the documents in the file, Jeremy moved to uphold the denial. Adam seconded the motion. Jeremy, Adam, and Jared voted in favor. Michelle opposed. The motion to uphold the denial passed 3-1.

Andrew Noack (absentia): Still under oath, Agent Marshall read the disposition on behalf of Sgt. Zaugg: On November 25, 2025, Mr. Noack's Utah concealed firearm permit was denied based on a March 4, 1999, first-degree felony conviction involving burglary out of the state of Oregon. After reviewing all the documents in the file, Adam moved to uphold the denial. Jared seconded the motion. Adam and Jared voted in favor of the motion. Michelle and Jeremy opposed. Since the vote resulted in a tie, the Bureau's decision to deny the license stands and constitutes the final agency action.

Dustin Cisneros (absentia): Still under oath, Agent Marshall read the disposition on behalf of Sgt. Zaugg: On January 8, 2026, Mr. Cisneros' Utah concealed firearm permit was denied based on an August 8, 2024, misdemeanor conviction involving grand theft in the state of California. After reviewing all the documents in the file, Michelle moved to uphold the denial. Adam seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

Motion to set the next hearing date: The next hearing was previously determined to be Tuesday, August 25, 2026. The Board approved to reserve November 17, 2026 for the following meeting.

The Attorney General's Office provided the annual Open and Public Meetings Act (OPMA) training.
