## Bountiful City Notice of Budgetary Public Hearings

Public notice is hereby given that the Mayor and City Council of Bountiful City, Utah will hold the following five public hearings to receive public input on the proposed budgetary actions:

1. Fiscal year 2026 - Public hearing to authorize an additional \$100,000 in transfers from the Light and Power Fund to the General Fund above the existing transfer budget of \$3,164,831.
2. Fiscal year 2026 - Public hearing to open the budget for consideration of various increases and decreases (i.e., amendments) in budgeted revenues and expenditures.
3. Fiscal year 2027 - Public hearing to authorize \$3,291,424 in transfers from the Light and Power Fund to the General Fund in the 2027 budget.
4. Fiscal year 2027 - Public hearing on fiscal year 2027 compensation increases for employees including executive municipal officers
5. Fiscal year 2027 - Public hearing to consider the entire fiscal year 2027 budget before final adoption. Said budget is for municipal services for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2026, and ending June 30, 2027. A copy of the tentative budget will be available for public inspection at City Hall and on the [www.bountifulutah.gov/Financial-Reports](http://www.bountifulutah.gov/Financial-Reports) website for at least ten days prior to the public hearing.

Each of these public hearings will be held during the regular City Council Meeting which begins at 7:00 p.m. on Tuesday, June 9, 2026. The meeting location will be in the Bountiful City Hall Council Chambers, 795 South Main Street, Bountiful, Utah. The public is invited and encouraged to participate in these hearings.
