**Campus Allocation:** \$204,378.00

**Mountainville TSSA Plan:** Mountainville Academy will utilize 45% of TSSA funds for salaries and retention to support high-quality educators. The remaining 55% will focus on a schoolwide priority: increasing the percentage of students reading on grade level.

- Current data indicates that not all students meet grade-level reading benchmarks as measured by Acadience Reading and RISE ELA. While overall performance is improving, continued focus is needed to strengthen early literacy and accelerate growth for students below benchmark.
- Mountainville Academy will ensure **80% or more of students in grades K–5 are reading at or above grade level**, as measured by Acadience End-of-Year benchmarks, with at least a **2% increase from BOY to EOY**. Students below benchmark will demonstrate **typical or above-typical growth**. As a summative outcome, **RISE ELA proficiency will increase by at least 2% in grades 3–5**.
- To meet this goal, the school will strengthen Tier 1 instruction through professional learning aligned to the science of reading, including explicit instruction in phonics, fluency, vocabulary, and comprehension. **A Reading Specialist** will provide daily Tier 2 intervention for students below benchmark through targeted small group instruction.
- Acadience Reading will be used at BOY, MOY, and EOY, with progress monitoring every 1-2 weeks for students below benchmark. Teachers will meet regularly in PLCs to analyze data and adjust instruction and intervention.
- Personalized learning will be supported through programs such as Lexia, with usage and data monitored for instructional alignment. Literacy will be reinforced across content areas, including integration within STEM to support comprehension and academic vocabulary.
- This plan prioritizes measurable growth in grade-level reading through aligned instruction, targeted intervention, and consistent use of data.
