**C. New Business:**

**C.1. Art Banner at Heritage Splash Pad-** Arts Council talked about different options for the large banner at the Heritage Splash Pad. We decided to go with one of the pictures from the Art show, the Art Council decided to use Callie Dew's artwork of a dog swimming. Tiffany will contact Callie for the release and order the banner, so that it can be hung by Memorial.

**C.2. Utility Box art from Art Show-** There were a few pieces from the Art Show that the Arts Council indicated they would like to see on utility boxes. Three were approved: the koala, the cougar, the horses, and the train. Tiffany will contact all of the artists and see if they would be interested and sign a release form.

**C.3. Jordan River Trail submissions-** We had one entry of a mountain scene. Arts Council approved the artwork, and we mentioned putting it on the wall outside of Mulligan's. Tiffany will work with the artist and check with Brad and Janell if that wall is fine to paint.

**C.4. Upcoming Art Series-** Tiffany passed out the calendar of art events coming up for the Art Series. Some are under Arts programming, and some are Arts Council. We talked about where we would need help from the Arts Council is mostly Plein Air and Chalk Art Judging and the Parade.

**C.5. Plein Air, Holt Farmstead, May 30 from 9:30 am -1 pm-** We need 2-3 Arts Council members to help judge the Plein Air competition, on May 30 from 12-1 pm.

**C.6. SoJo Summerfest and Chalk Art Festival-** We need 2-3 Arts Council members who would like to be in the parade for SoJo Summerfest. Amy volunteered, but we will still need 1-2 more. For Chalk Art we need 2-3 Arts Council members who can help judge chalk art on June 6, at 2 pm. Janis said she should be able to, so we will still need 1-2 more.

**C.7. Theater- June 19-27-** Tiffany will need your ticket choice by the next Arts Council meeting, on May 14.

- D. Misc.-** We are able to apply for a one-time grant, and there are a few options that would be good for the Art Council. There were some training opportunities and a one-time temporary art installation. The Funds will need to be matched, but we can also use labor and materials. The Arts Council decided to go for this project and see if we can get something going with a rotating interactive art installation on Towne Center Dr., and possibly have the base done when they redo Towne Center.
