Approval of Minutes:

- No quorum to approve the minutes

Board Business:

- No quorum to elect a Chair

Financial Report:

- Dawn is out of town but sent over information to Jeff
- Jeff reviewed December-March revenue- \$239,000 in 2025 and \$391,000 in 2026
- Gray column in Dawn's report is March prior year- \$100,000 ahead of last year.
- Course has consistently increased revenue in the years since 2020

Women's Association Report:

- Opening Social is April 28
- Will ask for assistance on Witches on the Green tournament
- Tutus for Tatas is scheduled the 1st week of June
- Would like to involve America 250 theme in the July red, white & blue tournament.
- Would usually be on a Tuesday- July 7th

Men's Association Report:

- Ice breaker was 2 weeks ago- went well, good turnout, great weather
- New members joined
- Murdock donated to the prize payout \$2300 total
- Still working with sponsors for tournament prizes
- Old Grist Mill donated 2 months' worth of lunch cards- shared with Ladies Association
- Summer Solstice and Fall on the River are highly favored tournaments in the valley.
- During summertime (including ladies) \$800 a week goes into the slush fund. Last week was \$1100.

Update on Cart Replacement:

- Jeff gave a brief interactive presentation of the new software to track cart activity
- Shows data of where carts were on the course. Lines everywhere
- Allowed golfers to just drive new carts- allowing Jeff and Randy to see the Action Zones they needed to zone off and have cart GPS prohibit access
- Only allowing carts to be on cart path- zoned off protected wetlands
- Orange areas are “slow down areas” – slows down carts to 2 miles an hour
- There are 3 software package options staff must select in the next 60 days.

Golf Superintendent Report:

- Busy keeping up with mowing- in the summer staff mows 300 acres a week

- Melissa and Ashley have been great additions to staff
- March was crazy this year - \$171,000 more than last year
