1. Each Board Member was given the opportunity to offer their thoughts and opinions regarding the district master plan.
2. Ms. Leydsman from MHTN went through the survey they conducted with district employees.
  - a. Board Member Woolstenhulme asked if a similar survey would be sent to the community. Ms. Leydsman replied that this is the next step in the plan.
3. Guiding Principles: - see hand out
  - a. Community Focused
  - b. Fiscal Responsibility
  - c. Flexibility & Future Focused
  - d. High Quality Learning Environments

4. Four Phase plan
  - a. Phase One - does not need a bond
  - b. Phase Two - 1 to 5 years
  - c. Phase Three - 5 to 20 years
  - d. Phase Four - 20 + years
5. Bond: On the ballot in November is a constitutional amendment regarding bonds. Mr. Parker from MHTN is seeking clarification from the LT. Governor's Office regarding this amendment. He will update the board as soon as he receives it.
6. Board Member Metcalf commented that the board needs to decide what they are doing with the Jordan Property and the plan for it should be included in the discussions with the plan for future schools.
7. Business Administrator Robinson commented that the district could start saving some money from the capital budget to go toward the expense of the plan.
8. The board preferred the Illustration of Concept 4. This concept keeps the middle school students away from the high school students and puts an auditorium and field house between the two buildings.
