- a) Great Salt Lake Basin Integrated Plan Public Engagement Presentation, Discussion & Input : Cody Lutz and Emma Clinton, with Envision Utah, will facilitate a public engagement presentation and discussion, and seek Watershed Council and public input for planning scenarios to guide current and future efforts, and inform the continued development of the Great Salt Lake Basin Integrated Plan. Envision Utah is working with all of the Great Salt Lake related watershed councils to help gather input from community leaders, stakeholders, and the general public. - b) Jordan River 2026 e.Coli TMDL Addendum Update : Samuel Taylor, Watershed Scientist, and Sandy Wingert, Provo and Jordan River Coordinator, with the Utah Division of Water Quality, will share an update of the Jordan River 2026 e.Coli Total Maximum Daily Load (TMDL) Addendum regarding clean water impairments, with recommendations to address long term river and watershed implications and health. This Addendum addresses the Bingham Creek and City Creek sub-basins, both tributaries to the Jordan River. This TMDL is currently open for public review and comment until June 16, 2026.
