TOPIC: BUCKSKIN HILLS DISCUSSION WITH UINTAH COUNTY

DISCUSSION	<p>Commissioner Norton moved to approve a special Session. Motion passed unanimously. Lorn discussed that the water pressure at Buckskin Hills has too many sprinklers are running all at once and pressure has been turned up without our knowledge and it is causing multiple issues with leaky gaskets down the line. Sometimes they continue to call multiple individuals until someone agrees to turn it up. Scott recommended a PRV downstream so we can run higher pressure. Our system is 50 years old and our system can't run with higher pressure. Putting a PRV below only solves half the issue. To protect our system, we need to maintain the pressure and our gaskets on the pipe. Scott clarified that sprinklers aren't the issue the water trucks trying to fill are the issue. They will only be using 2-3 acft per year. We asked if they could do a storage tank and prefill before races and have it ready. Then there aren't hydrants turning on and off and causing water hammering. Discussed turning the pressure up about 5 lbs. which will help them. Commissioner Norton asked about Redwash Road project, discussed those completing it hit our water line. Randan asked about future projects and for us to be made aware prior so we can coordinate. Commissioner Norton said they are working on 500 North from 1500 E to the landfill. Trudy asked about the ATV trail by buckskin hills she commented it could be on the south side or north side depending on right of ways.</p>
