A. CALL TO ORDER – 3:00 PM

Chairman Mike Walker called the meeting to order at 3:00pm.

Mayor Catlin noted that City Manager Ben Billingsley has replaced Bailey Guthrie as the City Representative.

B. APPROVAL OF AGENDA:

1. The Committee reviewed the agenda.

C. CONSENT AGENDA:

1. **Review and possible approval** of meeting minutes from April 23, 2026, Committee Meeting.

D. PRESENTATION:

1. City Manager – Ben Billingsley

Ben Billingsley presented a slideshow going over City priorities and funding opportunities. Ben went over priorities such as supporting long-term water source protection and reliability, safety, revenue neutrality, and amenities that serve diverse user groups. Ben talked about trail development and connectivity, creating a more local place for families to recreate, encouraging healthy lifestyles and building community pride, as well as economic benefit. Ben noted he gathered these priorities from discussions with elected officials. Ben continued his presentation going over funding opportunities such as Utah Outdoor Recreation Grant, the Washington County Tourism Tax Advisory Board, Parks Rec and Trails Impact Fees, and RAP Tax Proceeds. Ben answered questions from the other Committee members regarding grant timelines and amounts.

E. DISCUSSION ITEMS:

1. Discussion on Required Infrastructure.

Mayor Catlin noted that the committee needs to establish an outline for phasing to meet the requirements of the Bureau of Land Management. He mentioned the City Council has discussed amending the hillside ordinance to allow for trails around the reservoir. The Committee discussed putting in utilities such as water, sewer, and power, as well as a boat ramp and parking lot.

2. Discussion on Conceptual Layout and Phased Amenities.

The Committee discussed phasing in camping areas and trails, along with making them ADA compliant. The Committee discussed identifying more funding opportunities.

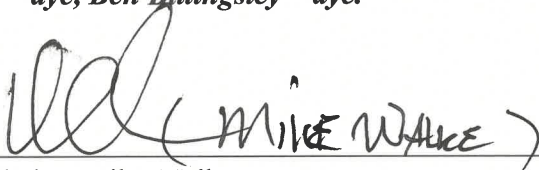
3. Discussion on Agenda Items for May 21, 2026, Committee Meeting.
