MONTICELLO CITY PARKS WATER USAGE

As requested, here is a report on the Secondary water usage at parks maintained by the City of Monticello. The Secondary was not charged to Pioneer Park, Veterans Park or the Ballfields Park until the week of April 27th – May 1st. Circle Park wasn't done until the week of May 11th-15th.

These numbers reflect the total gallons of Secondary water used to date this year.

Pioneer Park:

Starting Usage: 4,365

Ending Usage: 4,380

Total Usage this year so far: 15,000 gallons

Veterans Park:

Starting Usage: 3,461

Ending Usage: 3,544

Total Usage this year so far: 83,000 gallons

Circle Park:

Starting Usage: 1,445

Ending Usage: 1,463

Total Usage this year so far: 18,000 gallons

Ballfields Park:

Starting Usage: 11,216

Ending Usage: 11,654

Total Usage this year so far: 438,000 gallons

Total Locations YTD 2026: 554,000
