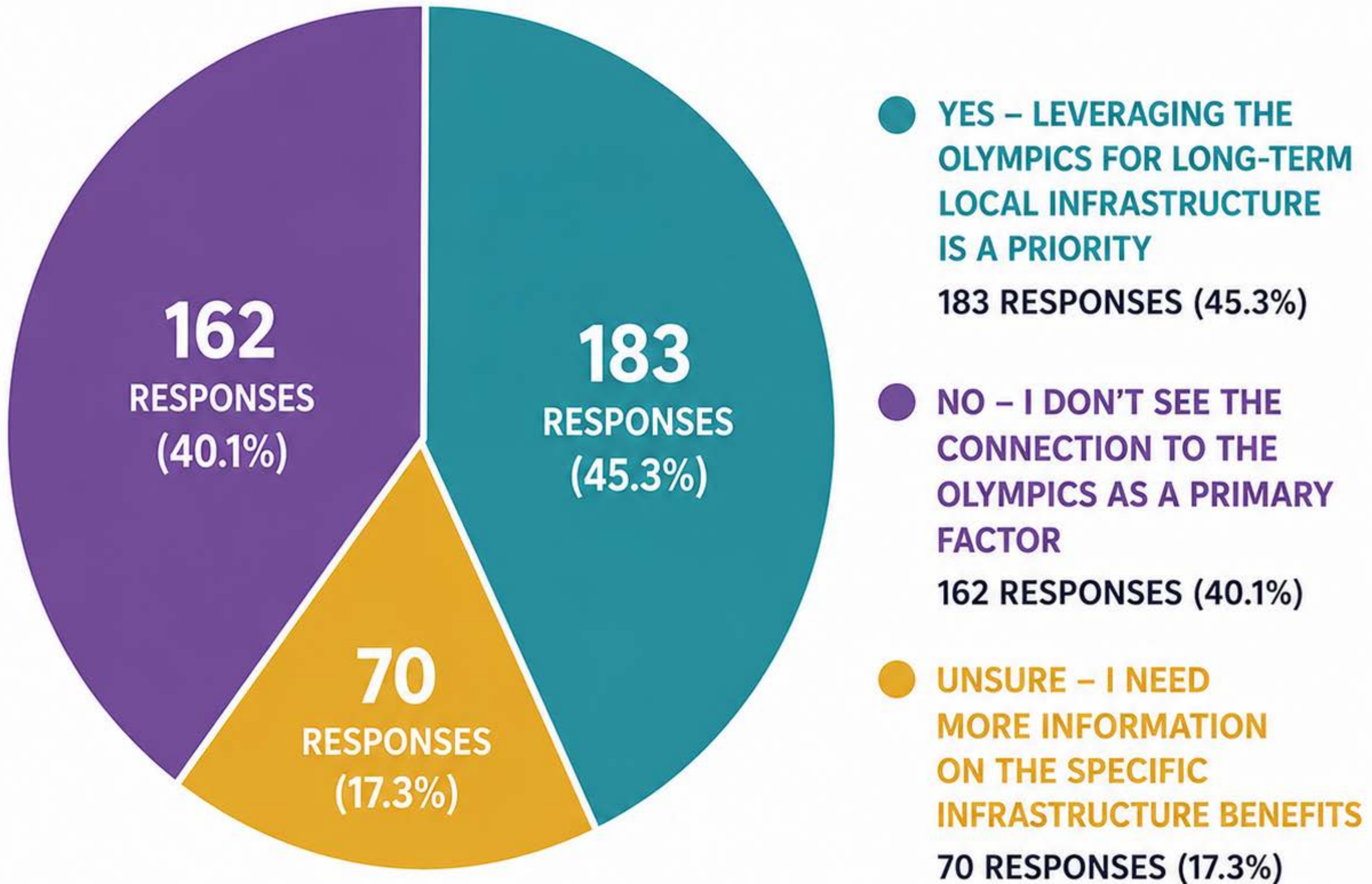


Kearns Clean Energy Survey Results

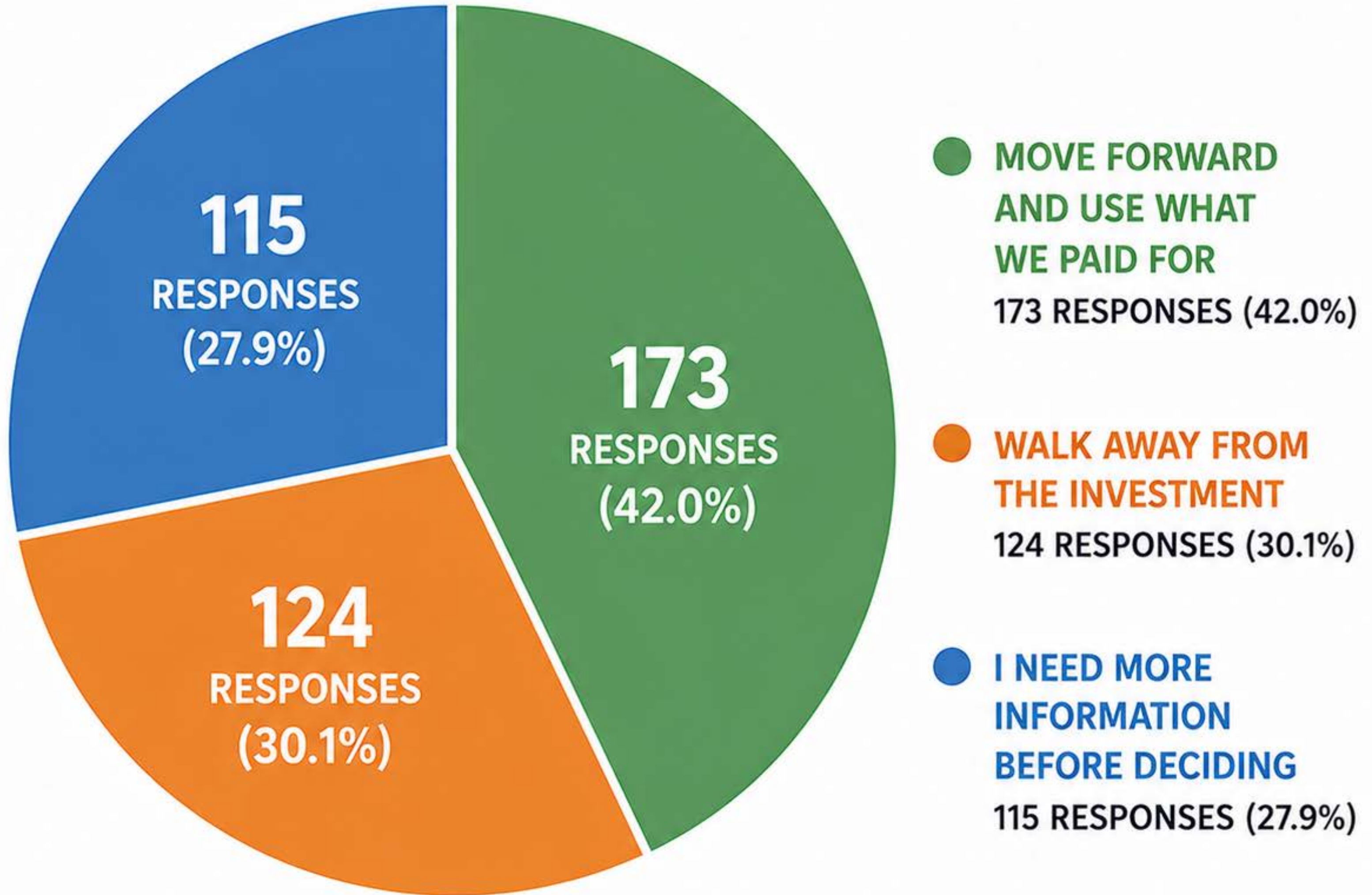

Kearns has already invested financially to help design this program. Should the City move forward to receive the benefits of that investment, or terminate our participation and the current investment?

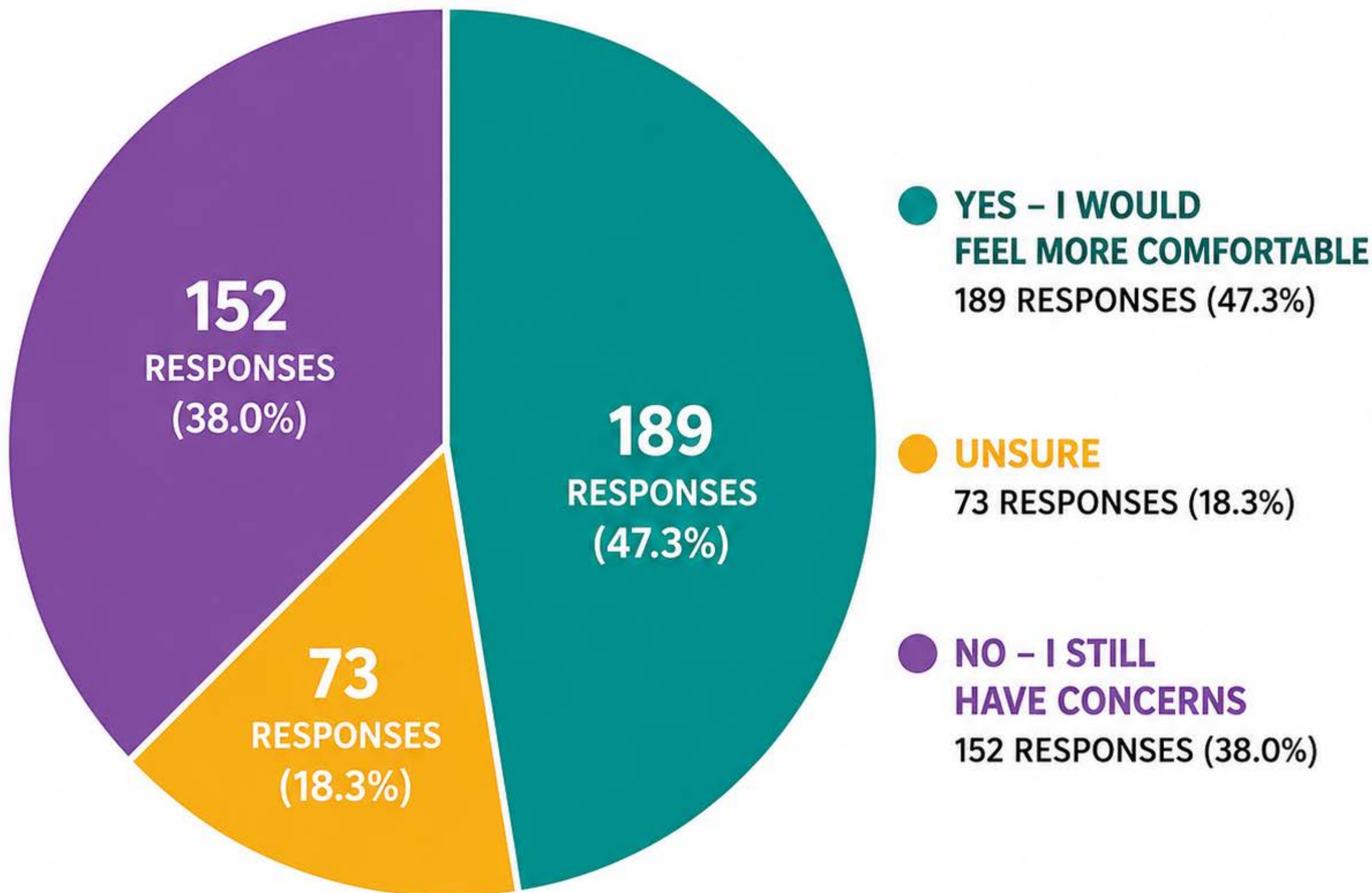

If opting out is as simple as returning an included paper form, clicking a link in your online account, or calling a 1-800 number – would you feel more comfortable with Kearns joining the program?

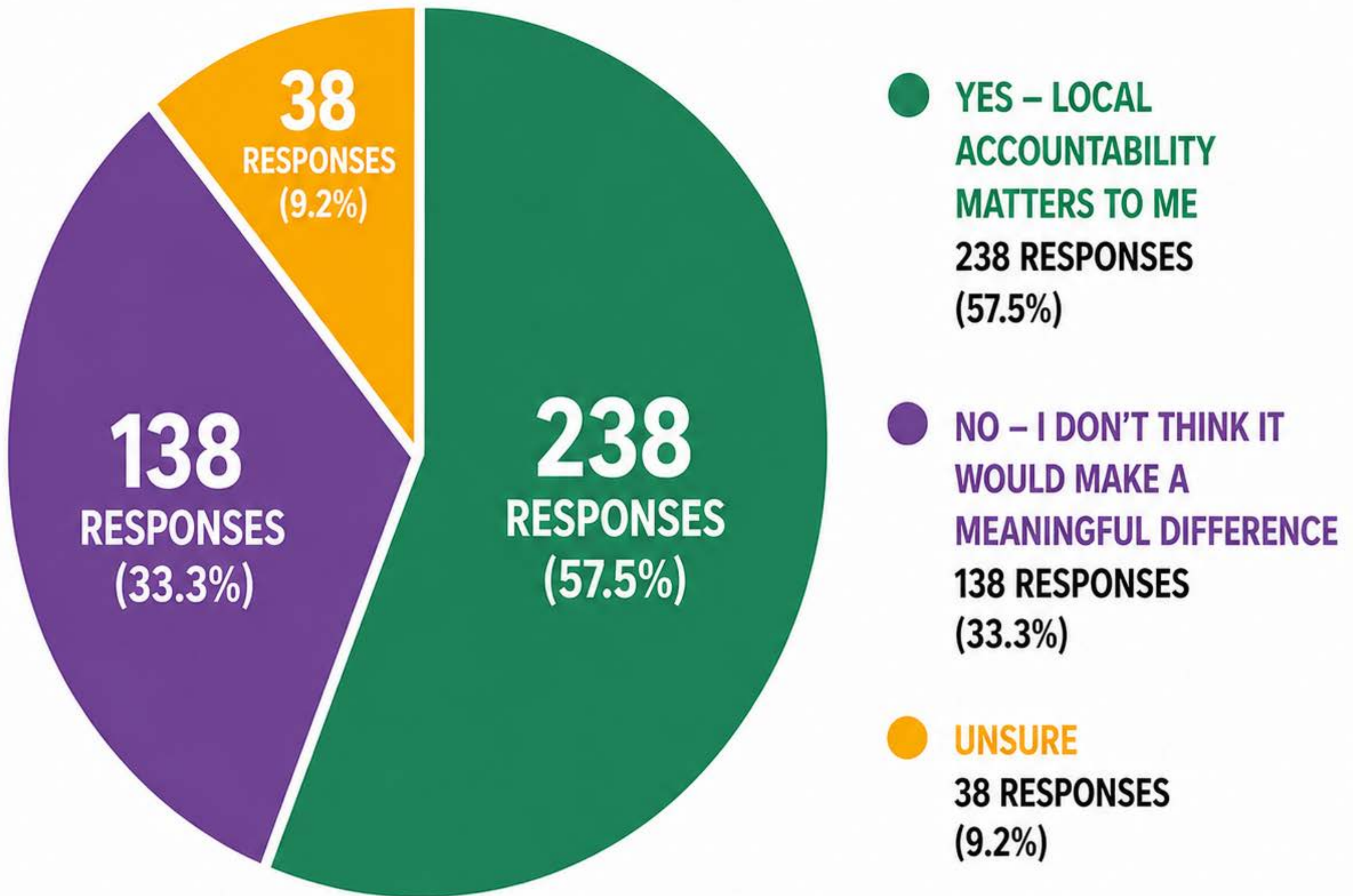
