Having said that, I urge you not to act on Item C. 1 at the special meeting on Friday regarding the development of a medical clinic building. I know this has gone very far down the road to completion, but I, along with a great many of my fellow residents, have never been able to successfully resolve persistent concerns regarding the actual need for such a large, expensive endeavor. In addition, there are concerns regarding the process going forward, and ultimately, simply the cost.

At a very minimum, I beg you to table this until you know this is what the community really wants and needs.

I listened carefully to all of the candidates at last fall's open houses, and even though I ultimately voted for some of you who supported the medical clinic, I didn't fully appreciate the scope of the proposal and the potential harms to the Town's financial health down the line. I am late to the conversation, and I apologize for speaking up at the eleventh hour.
