

MINUTES OF THE STUDY SESSION – MAY 14, 2026

The Board of Education of the Lake Mountain School District met in a study session on Thursday, May 14, 2026, at 4:00 PM. The study session took place in the board room at the Lake Mountain School District office in Saratoga Springs, UT.

Board members present: President Julie King, Vice President Matt Isaacson, Charity Judkins, Joylin Lincoln, Julie Myers, Melissa Sauser, and Ilene Strong.

Also present: Superintendent Carter and members of the administrative staff. There were approximately 3 others in attendance. Absent: Deputy Superintendent Bollinger.

Data at the Secondary Level/Data Gateway Review for Elementary

Jason Crowton, Director of Results & Achievement in Alpine School District presented secondary and elementary school report cards and school improvement data to the Board of Education, including a variety of metrics and student group performance indicators used to evaluate how individual schools and student populations are performing. He reviewed the data points the District uses to measure overall performance compared to the metrics utilized by the State, demonstrated how to access data sets through Data Gateway, and explained the various assessments administered at different grade levels to measure student growth and achievement. Current and historical data trends were also shared with the Board.

Mr. Crowton fielded questions from the Board of Education.

ATEC West Concept Plans

President King presented the conceptual plan for the ATEC West campus to the Board of Education, reviewing proposed additions and updates to the facility. She noted that Board leadership met with staff and parents to gather input on the design and shared that the District is working closely with the developer throughout the process. A 15-year lease is anticipated for the location as a long-term solution. Occupancy is expected in December of this year, with students anticipated to begin utilizing the new facility in January 2027. President King added that students have been told the new facility is their Christmas present.

President King fielded questions from the Board of Education.
