DISCUSSION ITEMS

Shay Morrison, Community Advisor.

He thanked those who went to the R6 Regional Summit. The CIB deadline will be June 1st, October 1st, and February 1st 2027. All projects need to be on the list. We are not eligible this year to do Truth and Taxation, it had to be included in our tentative budget. Council Member Nedreberg was explaining how we should do a small increase every year. We need to let the taxpayers know how the process works. Mayor Jenkins asked about the WUI Map. Shay has not heard anything yet.

Dan Fechner, City Engineer. – Review of Transportation Plan.

Matthew Lenhart went over the Transportation plan. There was a discussion on the maps, adding streets to possible annexed areas to the East and West of town. A public hearing will be needed before the Transportation plan can be adopted. A comment box will be put out in the lobby for public comment. A public hearing for the water project will be June 8th and June 17th for the Transportation Plan
