**CITIZEN COMMENTS**

(Citizens who wish to address the Council may do so at this time. All comments will be documented in the minutes, however, no action can be taken at this meeting due to not being on the agenda. Any item requiring a vote will need to be placed on the next regular Council Meeting Agenda). *Limited to three minutes.*

Shelly Stansfield came forward and said she was supposed to be on the agenda for local consent. Council Member Clements made a motion to put Shelly on tonight's agenda. Council Member Nedreberg seconded the motion. All in favor motion carried. Shelly explained that she was requesting local consent from the Council for single-event licenses for the Company Store on June 13th and August 16th, and for the Tintic Elks Lodge on August 15th. Council Member Nedreberg made a motion to accept the applications. Council Member Clements seconded the motion. All in favor motion carried.

**DISCUSSION ITEMS/ACTION ITEMS**

Shay Morrison, Community Advisor.

Shay presented his topics at the Work Meeting. No approvals or votes were required.

Dan Fechner, Jones & DeMille, review and Approval of Eureka Transportation Plan.

Dan gave his presentation at the public open house and work meeting. A public hearing is required before the Transportation Plan can be voted on.

Review and Approval of Tentative Budget for Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 2027.

Council Member Nedreberg made a motion to approve the tentative budget for Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 2027. Council Member Clement seconded the motion. A roll call vote was taken all in favor motion carried.

Resolution to Add Dave Sanderson to PTIF Accounts.

Mayor Jenkins would like to add the accountant to the PTIF accounts. Council Member Nedreberg made a motion to have a resolution to add Dave Sanderson to the city's PTIF Accounts. Shay reminded them there is a limit of how many people can be on the account. Council Member Nedreberg amended his original motion and added at the Mayor's discretion he can remove a person from the PTIF accounts if needed. Council Member Davis seconded the motion. A roll call vote was taken all in favor motion carried.

City Truck Purchase.

Council Member Nedreberg made a motion to authorize the Mayor to look at getting bids to purchase a city truck. Council Member Clements seconded the motion. Council Member Maxfield wanted clarification of the motion. After a small discussion Council Member Nedreberg withdrew his original motion and made a new motion to allow the Mayor to purchase one of the two surplus trucks he already has bids on. Council Member Clements seconded the new motion. A roll call vote was taken all in favor motion carried.

Mayor Jenkins said he needed to get the list from Tyler before anything can be done. There was a discussion on how the bids would be taken.

Council Member Davis said the committee met with the Mayor and Tyler to discuss the Veterans Memorial. They decided to have the Recreation Committee do it this year. He also went to the cemetery with the Mayor and Tyler to look at some issues with the memorial and discussed how to address them. He has been working with Recorder Bigler to get the Veterans information updated.

The park has three dead trees that need to be removed. He wants to replace two of the three trees. One of the trees is right next the pavilion and he doesn't want to put a new one there. He is asking for suggestions on what type of trees to replace them. A couple of different trees were

mentioned. He would really like to put in a shade tree. He also met with Tyler at the city shop and went over tools and equipment. He would like to get a general mechanics mixed set to keep down there. Tyler made a request with him for a gas powered asphalt saw, another riding lawn mower, and battery power weed eaters. Going back to the cemetery he had asked the Mayor to look into how the cemetery is laid out and if the maps correspond with the layout. Council Members Davis and Clements offered their help to Recorder Bigler with cemetery records. The Chamber of Commerce had help from Sonja and Council Member Nedreberg with designing and setting up a website. The link is available on the city website. The website can be updated and edited at any time. He explained how one of the features on the website works. They have finally settled on a day to hold their meetings. It will be the 4<sup>th</sup> Wednesday of each month at 7:00 pm. They have been holding them at B's but the city has offered the use of this building. He said the Recreation Committee would like to see the Mayor and Council help with this year's celebration. So don't be surprised if you are asked to help.

Council Member Kimberly Clements – Nothing to report

Council Member Thomas Nedreberg – He went to the ULCT meeting and the R6 meeting. He heard a lot about water fees during these meetings. Mayor Jenkins said the tiered water rates are already being worked on. Council Member Maxfield explained what has been done and why. He said the Mayor had talked to him about getting new computers for the Council. He requested they be added to the new budget. Recorder Bigler said one of the new tablets for the maintenance workers cannot be used therefore a new one is required.
