Dear Participant,

Thank you for your support of our event and of our great Kearns community. We ask you follow these guidelines.

- Event will be outdoors and probably hot. Oquirrh Park does not have specific shaded areas. Please plan accordingly.
- Consumption of alcohol beverages, recreational pharmaceuticals, or any illegal substance is strictly forbidden.
- Upon your arrival we will have someone to check you in and direct you to where your booth will be located and where you can park to un-load items if necessary.
- Porta potties will be available.
- You can begin to set up your booth area as early as 4:00 pm. Event begins at 5:00 pm.
- Booth size is 10' x 10', please don't encroach over that. Space is tight. If you need extra space please indicate in the "Additional Information" area of your registration form.
- You will need to bring all your own supplies for your booth, table, chairs, canopy, etc...
- No selling of anything, no solicitations for donations, everything you give out must be free to all. Our entire event is free, except for food. Food trucks will be available for food purchase.
- We do not have power or water available at the park. If you need these items you will need to bring you own.
- Booth, table, etc.. must meet the standards of the Kearns Community Council and our Kearns community. If that is not met, you may be asked to leave.
- We do not allow booths or individuals, that have weapons of any kind, to show, no music in the booth, and the booth and all who are involved with it must be respectful of everyone and the community.
- Keep your booth area clean at all times. After the event please make sure your area is clean.

We ask that everyone be courteous and respectful, we are here to enjoy the day. Parade Guidelines

Dear Parade Participant,

2026

Thank you for supporting our Kearns Parade. We ask that you follow these few parade guidelines in order to make it an enjoyable and safe event for everyone.

- **Parade Date:** Saturday August 8, 2026. Parade begins promptly at 9:00 AM. Traditional parade route—travels North on Cougar Lane (4800 West), then travels East on 5400 South (5415 South), ending in the Big Lots parking lot on 5400 South,
- **Staging Area:** You may arrive as early as 7:00 AM on parade day. Arrive no later than 8:30 am. Staging will be at Kearns High School, 5525 South Cougar Lane (4800 West), in the front main parking lot. Our staging crew will direct you from there. For large entries it is best to come on 6200 South to Cougar Lane heading West and turn right onto Cougar Lane.
- **Check In:** When you arrive an official will greet you as your entry pulls into the parking lot at Kearns High School. They will let you know at that time your parade number and direct you to where you are to park for parade preparation and staging.
- **Entry Judging:** The judging will begin at 7:30 am, if you plan to be in the judging please make sure your entry is ready to go.
- **Parade Route:** Parade route, 5400 South Street is now a very wide road. You will be required if you will be tossing candy, flyers, etc... from your entry that you use walkers alongside your entry to toss out the items. We don't want anyone coming into lanes of the parade traffic.
- **Secure Entry:** Make sure those riding on your entry are secured as well as any articles that may accompany your entry. If you run into a problem with your entry please pull to the side quickly allowing the other entries to go around you in a safe manner.
- **Temperature:** It will most likely be a very hot parade day, so please bring your own water, etc... for your entry. Dehydration, sunstroke, etc... can set in quickly on a hot day. There will not be any provided.
- **Restroom Facility:** Porta pottie will be available in the staging area at the south end of the parking lot.
- **Parade End:** Parade end will be in the Big Lots parking lot, 5400 South 4000 West. **As you finish pull towards the front of the store quickly so that other entries can move in and out quickly.** For those needing to pick up people from an entry pick up will be there as well, however understand pick up may be delayed due to the remaining entries finishing the parade.
- **Vendors:** Any vendors, sales people, school clubs, organizations wishing to walk alongside the parade route must be registered as a parade entry otherwise you will be asked to leave the parade route. **No exceptions.** This does not apply to walkers or those affiliated with an entry that is already registered to be in the parade.

- **Right of Refusal:** The Kearns Community Council/Committee, and the City of Kearns Council reserve the right to refuse any entry that is not conducive to our Kearns community standards. If you are asked to leave the parade do so quickly and do not try to re-enter the parade somewhere else along the parade route.
- **UPD:** Unified Police Department—Kearns Precinct will be handling all traffic control, parade traffic control, managing the roads, and controlling the parade route. Thank them as you go by, most of them are volunteering their time.
- **Preparation:** Please be prepared with your entry when you arrive. Supplies like tape, rope, markers, etc... will not be available or provided for you. All non-entries **must** park in the very South end of the parking lot, even if dropping off someone for the entry.

We ask that everyone be courteous and respectful, we are here to enjoy the day.
