<p>AGENDA ITEM SUMMARY: LIMIT 150 WORDS</p>	<p>Consideration of Resolution No. 26-16 adopting the final Budget of the City of Taylorsville for Fiscal Year 2026-2027. The proposed Budget establishes appropriations, revenues, expenditures, and operational funding for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2026, and ending June 30, 2027. The Budget was previously presented as a tentative budget, made available for public inspection, and considered following a duly noticed public hearing conducted in accordance with Utah law. Adoption of the Resolution authorizes implementation and administration of the approved Budget.</p>

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF TAYLORSVILLE ADOPTING A FINAL
BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 2026 AND ENDING
JUNE 30, 2027**

WHEREAS, the Taylorsville City Council (the “Council”) met in regular session on June 3, 2026, to consider, among other things, adopting a final budget for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2026, and ending June 30, 2027; and

WHEREAS, on May 6 and May 20, 2026, the Budget Officer of the City of Taylorsville (the “City”) submitted to the Council a tentative budget including all supporting schedules and data (the “Tentative Budget”) for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2026, and ending June 30, 2027; and

WHEREAS, the Council previously acknowledged receipt of and tentatively adopted the Tentative Budget and directed that the Tentative Budget be made available for public inspection in the office of the City Recorder during regular business hours; and

WHEREAS, notice of a public hearing to consider the Budget was properly provided in accordance with Utah law, including publication on the Utah Public Notice website, posting at City Hall, and publication on the City’s official website; and

WHEREAS, on May 20, 2026, at 6:30 p.m., a duly noticed public hearing to receive public comment and consider adoption of the final budget was held in the Council Chambers located at 2600 West Taylorsville Boulevard, Taylorsville, Utah; and

WHEREAS, all interested persons attending the public hearing were provided an opportunity to be heard and to speak in favor of or against the estimated revenues, expenditures, or any item thereof contained within the Tentative Budget; and

WHEREAS, the Council further finds that the proposed fiscal year 2026-2027 budget appropriately incorporates such compensation adjustments in compliance with applicable law and prior public notice and hearing requirements; and

WHEREAS, the Council finds that all legal prerequisites to the adoption of the final budget have been satisfied and that adoption of the final budget is in the best interests of the City and its residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Taylorsville City Council as follows:

Section 1. Budget Adoption.

A. The Tentative Budget attached hereto as Exhibit “A,” as amended, and incorporated herein by this reference, is hereby appropriated for the corporate purposes and objects of the City for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2026, and ending June 30, 2027, and is hereby adopted as the “Budget of the City of Taylorsville, Utah for the Fiscal Year 2026-2027.”

B. Pursuant to Utah Code § 10-6-118, a copy of the Budget for each fund within the Budget shall be certified by the Mayor as Budget Officer, and the City administration is hereby directed to file the Budget with the Utah State Auditor as required by law.

C. Pursuant to Utah Code § 10-6-118, a certified copy of the Budget shall be filed in the office of the City Recorder and shall be available for public inspection during regular business hours.

Section 2. Further Administrative Action.

A. The Mayor, Budget Officer, City Recorder, and other appropriate City officials are hereby authorized and directed to undertake all actions reasonably necessary to implement and administer the Budget consistent with this Resolution and applicable law.

B. The City administration shall complete all required filings, notices, certifications, and reporting obligations associated with adoption of the Budget.

C. All notices, hearing materials, Property Tax Impact Schedules, and supporting budget documents shall be preserved as part of the official legislative and administrative record of the City relating to the fiscal year 2026-2027 budget process.

Section 3. Severability.

If any provision of this Resolution is determined to be invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such determination shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions.

This Resolution, assigned Resolution No. 26-16, shall take effect immediately upon passage, approval, and posting as required by law.
