#4 State Legislative Session Wrap-up Discussion

Gilbert reviewed the Utah's 2023-2050 Unified Transportation Plan and HB 425. This bill legally codifies the ability of cities and counties to implement a universally applied transportation utility fee, provided it is based on a localized travel demand study that justifies the fee according to usage. Any collected fees must be tracked in a dedicated fund and applied strictly to transportation uses and maintenance

Committee and **Staff** discussed HB 425 and how it can be implemented and having staff create a memorandum of understanding for HB 425.

Gilbert reviewed SB 242 Sub 3: Transportation Amendments (Harper Bill). This bill carves out \$3 million for bus replacements in third through sixth-class counties, starting in July 2026. The required local match is determined on a sliding scale depending on how many local tax options the county has enacted; Cache County has enacted four of the five options, requiring a 60% match for replacement funds.

Committee and **Staff** discussed SB 242 and how the match works.

Gilbert reviewed HB 492 Sub 3: Transportation, Infrastructure, and Housing Amendment. This creates a new state revolving loan fund through the Governor's Office of Economic Opportunity (GOEO) that allows municipalities to apply for infrastructure funding (water, sewer, roads) tied specifically to planned affordable housing developments).
