



Planning Commission Meeting Public Hearing Notice

A public hearing will be held before the West Jordan Planning Commission on Tuesday, June 16, 2026, at 6:00 pm (or as soon thereafter as possible) at West Jordan City Hall, 8000 S. Redwood Rd, 3rd Floor, West Jordan, UT 84088.

The purpose of the hearing is to receive public comments regarding the following:

- Text Amendment – Landscaping Requirements, Recommendation to the City Council to Amend West Jordan City Code Title 13, Chapter 13 Landscaping Requirements; (City-wide Applicability)

- Visionary Center; 3680 West 9000 South; Approval of a Preliminary Site Plan and Preliminary Condominium Plat; P-O Zone; Preston Reading/Navigate CM & Development (applicant)
