City of Spanish Fork City Notice of Ordinance Adoption - June 2, 2026 City Council

1. Ordinance 10-2026 to Approve Title 5 Amendment for Directional Signs.

Ordinance 10-2026 amends Spanish Fork City Code Title 5 to allow larger directional signs on large commercial properties while maintaining existing limits for smaller sites. Under the amendment, directional signs on sites smaller than 10 acres remain limited to 6 square feet in sign area and 3 feet in height, while sites larger than 10 acres with at least 600 feet of public street frontage may have directional signs up to 16 square feet in area and 4 feet in height. The change was requested by Wheeler Machinery Co. to improve traffic flow and wayfinding on its large site with multiple entrances, and City staff determined the amendment would help direct vehicles, including large trucks, without creating unnecessary sign clutter.
