

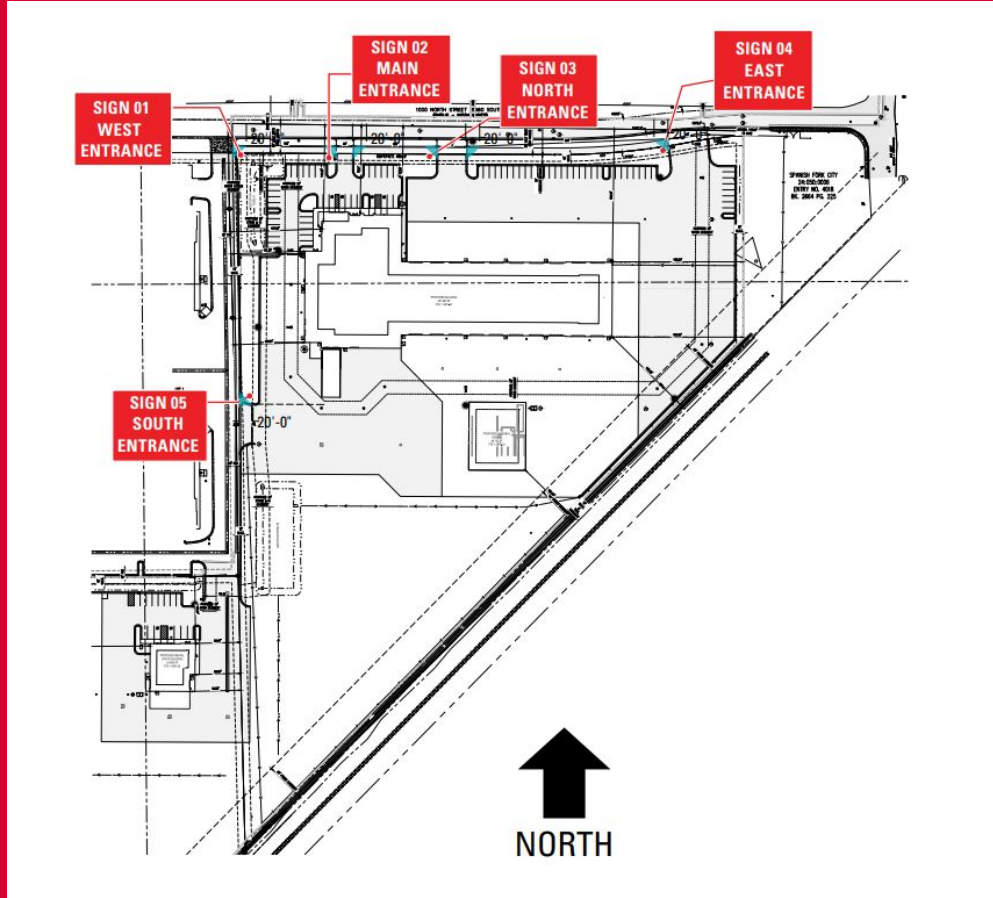


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Title 5 Amendment - Directional Signs





5.36.050 Permitted Permanent Signs

Permanent signs are limited to government signs and on-site commercial advertising signs, may be illuminated or non-illuminated, and must be located outside of any Clear Vision Areas. Permanent Signs may not be constructed of fabric material, such as vinyl or similar products, but rather must be constructed of a rigid material such as steel, aluminum, wood, or Lexan. An exception exists for signs constructed of fabric material during the first 60 days of business' initial opening. Reader Boards are permitted, and permanent signs are subject to meeting any applicable requirements found in the current edition of the building code adopted by the Utah Uniform Building Code Commission.

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- D. Directional Signs. Directional signs, when required to assist the flow of traffic, may not exceed six (6) square feet in copy area or a height of three (3) feet **for sites that are less than 10 acres in size. Directional signs on sites that are larger than 10 acres with at least 600 feet of public street frontage may not exceed sixteen (16) square feet of copy area or a height of four (4) feet.**
