**Welcome & Roll Call**

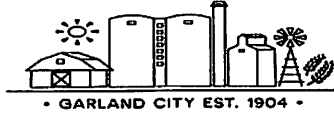
The City Council meeting began at 6:01 p.m. Mayor Austin called the meeting to order and welcomed those in attendance, including all Council Members, City staff, and members of the public.

**Department Head Reports**

**Police- Skyler Gailey**

Officer Gailey addressed the Council and reported that several officers traveled to Washington DC last week. They attended the National Memorial honoring Lee Sorensen and Eric Estrada. He shared highlights of the trip. While in Washington DC, they had opportunities to attend trainings. Lieutenant Gailey expressed appreciation to the City Council and community for their continued support. He stated



that the department is considering hosting a community giveback event. An invitation to the Fire Department was extended to participate in Torch Run tomorrow 5/22/26 at 10:00 A.M. A full-time Position will be opening up within Tremonton Police Department.

### **Fire Department**

Mayor Austin stated that he received a message from Cody McBride regarding a serious accident he was recently involved in. Mayor Austin reported that Mr. McBride is recovering and continuing to heal. There were no reports presented from the Fire Department.

### **Emergency Preparedness- Lanette Sorenson**

Ms. Sorenson reported that the text response to the Great Shake Out was received well, 100% text response. A Preparedness Fair was held, and was successful. She mentioned that increased advertising efforts may help encourage greater community involvement. Council Atkinson noted that funding is available in a budget for a new speed limit sign that is capable of broadcasting community events and announcements. Ms. Sorenson also reported that efforts are underway to secure a hand-washing station; however, shipping costs are higher than anticipated. She stated further that in place of the Peer Support activity this month, a first responder event will be held in June as part of the 4-H Club activity scheduled for June 2.

### **Code Enforcement- RaeAnn Bott**

RaeAnn Bott addressed the council and reported that HB33 permits political signs to be placed on private mow strips. She stated that she will be working to update the city ordinances so they align with HB33 and applicable state law. She also discussed Garland City Solicitation Permits, Traffic Code, and Dog Ordinance.

### **Mosquito Abatement-**

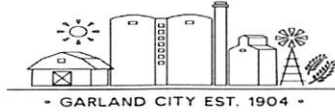
Councilmember Atkinson reported that a 513-acre mosquito abatement plan is currently in place and noted that drones may be utilized as part of the abatement efforts. She also stated that information regarding the mosquito abatement program was included in the city newsletter for residents

### **2026-2027 Preliminary Budget Review/Discussion**

Mayor Austin asked if there was any discussion regarding the preliminary budget review. Councilmember Atkinson requested clarification on several items. Mayor Austin stated that Tiffanie Smith would be able to address those questions and concerns.

### **Discussion on water overages for the past year**

Mayor Austin asked for discussion regarding how the council would like to proceed with water outages and what action, if any, should be taken. Councilmember Hall stated that he believes there should be a cap applied to usage above Tier One, defined as usage exceeding 30,000 gallons. Discussion followed regarding whether implementing such a cap would be fair and would promote accountability and conservation.
