

RESOLUTION NO. 18-2026

A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF AN INTERLOCAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN WEBER COUNTY, WEBER FIRE DISTRICT, AND OTHER PARTICIPATING FIRE SERVICE PROVIDERS FOR THE OPERATION OF THE WEBER COUNTY HEAVY RESCUE TEAM; AUTHORIZING THE BOARD CHAIR TO SIGN SUCH AGREEMENT; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

SECTION 1. RECITALS

WHEREAS, the Weber Fire District (the “District”) is a Local District created as a Service Area, a body politic and subdivision of the State of Utah, that provides fire protection and emergency services within its jurisdiction; and,

WHEREAS, in conformance with the provisions of Utah State Code, the Weber Fire District Board of Trustees as the governing body of the District may exercise all administrative powers by resolution; and,

WHEREAS, Weber County and participating fire service providers have proposed entering into an Interlocal Cooperation Agreement for the continued operation and coordination of the Weber County Heavy Rescue Team; and,

WHEREAS, the Interlocal Cooperation Agreement establishes the procedures, responsibilities, and cooperative framework for providing specialized technical rescue services including confined space, rope rescue, trench rescue, swift water rescue, structural collapse rescue, and related heavy rescue operations throughout Weber County; and,

WHEREAS, the Interlocal Cooperation Agreement provides for coordination of personnel, training, equipment, operational response, and funding among Weber County and participating agencies in support of regional heavy rescue operations; and,

WHEREAS, participation in the Weber County Heavy Rescue Team supports cooperative emergency response efforts and enhances public safety within the District and surrounding communities; and,

WHEREAS, the Board Chair is the authorized official of the District for purposes of executing operational agreements of this nature;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES THAT,

The Board of Trustees of the Weber Fire District, State of Utah, hereby authorizes approval of the “Interlocal Cooperation Agreement for Heavy Rescue Team Between Weber County and Fire Service Providers” (attached hereto as “Attachment A” and incorporated herein by this reference), and authorizes the Board Chair to sign any and all contracts, agreements, or other documents necessary to consummate said agreement; and, authorizes the District Clerk to sign any documents as may be required attesting to the fact that the Board Chair has been duly authorized to enter into such arrangements on behalf of the District.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.

SECTION 2. REPEALER OF CONFLICTING ENACTMENTS:

All orders and resolutions with respect to the changes herein enacted and adopted which have heretofore been adopted by the District, or parts thereof, which are in conflict with any of the provisions of this Resolution, are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed, except that this repeal shall not be construed to revive any act, order or resolution, or part thereof, heretofore repealed.

SECTION 3 - PRIOR RESOLUTIONS:

The body and substance of any and all prior Resolutions, together with their specific provisions, where not otherwise in conflict with this Resolution, are hereby reaffirmed and readopted.

SECTION 4 - SAVINGS CLAUSE:

If any provision of this Resolution shall be held or deemed to be or shall, in fact, be invalid, inoperative or unenforceable for any reason, such reason shall not have the effect of rendering any other provision or provisions hereof invalid, inoperative or unenforceable to any extent whatever, this Resolution and the provisions of this Resolution being deemed to be the separate independent and severable act of the Board of Trustees of the Weber Fire District.

SECTION 5. DATE OF EFFECT:

This Resolution shall be effective on the 9th day of June, 2026, and after publication or posting as required by law.
