

RESOLUTION NO. 20-2026

A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND ADOPTING THE WEBER FIRE DISTRICT COMMUNITY WILDFIRE PREPAREDNESS PLAN (CWPP); AUTHORIZING THE BOARD CHAIR AND FIRE CHIEF TO SIGN THE PLAN AND RELATED DOCUMENTS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

SECTION 1. RECITALS

WHEREAS, the Weber Fire District (the “District”) is a Local District created as a Service Area, a body politic and subdivision of the State of Utah, that provides fire protection, emergency response, and wildfire mitigation services within its jurisdiction; and,

WHEREAS, in conformance with the provisions of Utah State Code, the Weber Fire District Board of Trustees as the governing body of the District may exercise all administrative powers by resolution; and,

WHEREAS, the District has participated in the development of the Weber Fire District Community Wildfire Preparedness Plan (“CWPP”) in coordination with the Utah Division of Forestry, Fire and State Lands (FFSL) and other cooperating agencies and stakeholders; and,

WHEREAS, the CWPP identifies wildfire hazards, mitigation priorities, preparedness strategies, and cooperative actions intended to reduce wildfire risk and improve community resilience within the District service area; and,

WHEREAS, adoption of the CWPP supports compliance with the District’s Cooperative Wildland Fire Suppression (“CWS”) Agreement requirements and assists the District in maintaining eligibility for wildfire mitigation coordination, grant opportunities, and cooperative planning efforts; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees finds that adoption of the CWPP promotes public safety, enhances wildfire preparedness, and supports coordinated wildfire mitigation and response activities throughout the District; and,

WHEREAS, the Board Chair and Fire Chief are the authorized officials of the District for purposes of executing plans, agreements, and related documents of this nature;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES THAT,

The Board of Trustees of the Weber Fire District, State of Utah, hereby approves and adopts the “Weber Fire District Community Wildfire Preparedness Plan (CWPP)” (attached hereto as “Attachment A” and incorporated herein by this reference), and authorizes the Board Chair and Fire Chief to sign the CWPP and any related documents necessary to implement and effectuate said plan on behalf of the District.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.

SECTION 2. REPEALER OF CONFLICTING ENACTMENTS:

All orders and resolutions with respect to the changes herein enacted and adopted which have heretofore been adopted by the District, or parts thereof, which are in conflict with any of the provisions of this Resolution, are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed, except that this repeal shall not be construed to revive any act, order or resolution, or part thereof, heretofore repealed.

SECTION 3 - PRIOR RESOLUTIONS:

The body and substance of any and all prior Resolutions, together with their specific provisions, where not otherwise in conflict with this Resolution, are hereby reaffirmed and readopted.

SECTION 4 - SAVINGS CLAUSE:

If any provision of this Resolution shall be held or deemed to be or shall, in fact, be invalid, inoperative or unenforceable for any reason, such reason shall not have the effect of rendering any other provision or provisions hereof invalid, inoperative or unenforceable to any extent whatever, this Resolution and the provisions of this Resolution being deemed to be the separate independent and severable act of the Board of Trustees of the Weber Fire District.

SECTION 5. DATE OF EFFECT:

This Resolution shall be effective on the 9th day of June, 2026, and after publication or posting as required by law.
