Earl Taylor: Update Blackhawk Arena concessions **Taylor** stated that the Blackhawk Arena needs to hire a new concessionaire the previous concessionaire quit due to some communication issues. The Blackhawk has three upcoming events for which concessions will not be needed, and he has asked some food trucks to attend those events instead.

City Council agreed that food trucks may attend these upcoming events. The Blackhawk Board will begin accepting bids for a concessionaire contract. Once a new concessionaire is hired, food trucks will no longer be permitted at Blackhawk Arena events unless specifically invited by the new concessionaire. **Mayor Beach** discussed concerns about the cost of maintaining the kitchen equipment and suggested getting with the Blackhawk Board.
