Review of Budget Hearing Minutes and Meeting Minutes Approval

Josh made a motion to approve the minutes of January 8, 2026. Dennis seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Financial Reports/Bill Approval

Reports

- Chief's Report:
 - Brion Terry for Utah states all the contracts are up to date. It is unknown if the towns have signed contracts. The towns are responsible for paying for a fire if the fire starts in the municipality.
 - There are three construction companies in the county. How do they become available to send dozers on the fires? Brion states that the companies can sign up with the state. He will prepare information to provide to the companies
 - Duane asked where we are on getting a reimbursement back from the state for a training that was completed by the firefighters. Brion states the state will reimburse for equipment up to \$5,000 with receipts for the 2025 or 2026 years.

Fire Chief Position/Pay

WUI Code Enforcement

- If a house is in a high risk area the state needs to perform the assessment. The district can perform any other lot assessments. The county gets to decide how the lot assessments are completed in the county.
- Should the district charge for assessments? We are currently running on the 2006 WUI Code. In 2028 the WUI code will be updated to the 2026 code.
- Towns will need to adopt a WUI Code to be insured for fire in their towns.
