RESOLUTION NO. 26-17

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF TAYLORSVILLE RE-APPOINTING DAVID
YOUNG TO THE PLANNING COMMISSION AS A REPRESENTATIVE IN DISTRICT
NO. 1**

WHEREAS, the Taylorsville City Council (the “Council”) met in regular session on June 17, 2026, to consider, among other things, re-appointing David Young to the Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, TAYLORSVILLE MUNICIPAL CODE §13.03.030(A)(2)(a) directs that members of the City’s Planning Commission are to be appointed by the City Council, including one (1) alternate member; and

WHEREAS, David Young has been serving as District No. 1 representative on the Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, on January 7, 2026, the Taylorsville City Council appointed David Young to serve the remainder of the term vacated by former Commissioner Don Quigley and that term is about to expire; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to re-appoint David Young as the District No. 1 representative on the Planning Commission for an additional term expiring on June 30, 2030; and

WHEREAS, after careful consideration, the Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of the City’s citizens to re-appoint David Young as the District No. 1 representative on the Planning Commission for an additional term.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Taylorsville City Council that David Young is hereby re-appointed as the District No. 1 representative on the Planning Commission for an additional term.

This Resolution, assigned Resolution No. 26-17, shall take effect immediately upon passage and acceptance as provided herein.
