The meeting was called to order at 6:33 P.M. by Mayor Greg Pearson.

The minutes for the April 2026 meeting were reviewed.

Time was turned to Kelly Chappell to discuss the road project that will be starting soon. He stated that when they start they have 120 days to complete the project. The project was discussed and Greg Stephens was wondering if his customers would still be able to get into his store front. The project was discussed and the board asked a few questions to make sure that they understood the project.

The overdue water bills were discussed. The clerk will need to send out letters of concern to those on the list and a couple of disconnect notices.

The spring is still not producing enough water like in the past years at this time. It is usually pumping at 48 gallons per minute but it is closer to 30 gallons per minute. The board would like to see the town go to a watering schedule to make sure that we are preparing for the hot and dry

summer that is expected. The board would like to see the town go to a water schedule of watering on Tuesday and Saturdays from 6:00 am to 9:00 am and then again from 6:30 p.m. to 9:30 p.m. This will just be helpful so that the tanks do not run dry.

MOTION: Made by Councilman LeRell Barnson to set a water schedule for the town residents to water from 6:30 am- 9:30 am and then from 6:30 pm to 9:30 pm on Tuesdays and Saturdays.

The airport was discussed. The trees that are affecting the powerline by the end of the runway need to be cut down still. Councilman Coy and Councilman LeRell will get this taken care of. The drag races should take place at the end of the month.

The Cemetery grant was discussed. The grant should be spent out by June but the project has not started. Councilmember Mandy has been in contact with Amy Barry about the grant. Amy has stated that the town can file an extension for the project. This will allow us to continue on but have more time.

MOTION: Made by Councilmember Mandy Larsen to extend the cemetery project and file for the extension.

Councilman LeRell Barnson stated that Trey Pearson has been hired to take care of the lawn and restrooms. The mower is acting up and would like to see if they could purchase a new lawn mower. The funds are available in his budget.

The street mower tractor needs to have some new tires for the front. The Mayor stated that he would get some found and ordered.

The financial statement and bank statement for the month of April were available for review.


ORDER: Claims were available for the May payroll and accounts payable which goes from check # 12938 to check #12964.
