DISCUSSION ITEMS

Shay Morrison, Community Advisor.

Shay sent a survey to everyone about the Mayor/County Commissioner Meeting. Unfortunately, the link didn't work for Mayor Jenkins. He is interested in attending them. The State denied the change in the elementary school crosswalk and the one the city wanted to put in by the old bank on Mainstreet. He will continue to work with Recorder Bigler on the ARPA noncompliance issue. She could not find the close out window when she got into the system.

Dan Fechner, City Engineer – Review of Transportation Plan.

Dan said they are planning on holding a Public Hearing on June 17th before the Planning Commission Meeting. Council Member Atherley said he reviewed the Plan but not in depth. His recommendation is to adopt the Plan. Dan said the Booster designs are taking a bit longer than they anticipated. He had Matt Player with Delco Western come out and said the solenoid valve on the chlorine system is missing.

Capital Improvement Project List Review.

Council Member Maxfield believes we have three water projects, the roads, and the parking lot up at the park. She will finish getting the road projects uploaded.

Review of Tentative Budget for Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 2027.

Mayor Jenkins asked if the Council wanted to discuss and review the budget. There were no comments.

Councilor Atherley – Planning and Zoning.
He didn't have anything to report.

Councilor Clements – Parks and Recreation Veterans Memorial Discussion.

She said has talked to Briki Draper with Branded Barbers about doing a fundraiser for Eureka. She would like to create a Veterans Memorial and use the city property located across from the City Office. Shannon Memmott also had some resources available. Council Member Atherley felt a memorial with the names of the veterans would be very fitting. Council Member Davis said what they are after tonight is to have the city allocate the property across the street for the memorial. Mayor Jenkins would like to see some proposals for the memorial and how much space would be used. Shay suggested a committee be formed to handle the project.

Bookmobile.

Mayor Jenkins said there is a possibility the school may pay for it. He would also like to look into opening a physical library.

Recreation Committee structure and organization.

Mayor Jenkins said he has been asking for minutes and agendas of the meetings but is not getting any response. He also feels it would be more appropriate for the committee to start holding their meetings here at City Hall. The building is set up to hold and recorder meetings. He feels it is a constant battle to get information from the committee. He would like them to start using a city email so the communications start going through the City Office. This would help him and the Council be more informed. Council Member Clements disagreed with the Mayor about how things are communicated. There was a discussion on issues that Council Member Davis and Mayor Jenkins had.

Silver Jubilee/Depot Days Main Street closure discussion.

Mayor Jenkins would like to see the Silver Jubilee held on Main Street. Council Member Davis agrees. The Recreation Committee will be having some of the events back on Main Street this year. It was suggested when the celebration comes back to Main Street to contact either Juab County Sheriff of the Highway Patrol and have Main Street patrolled.
