SCADA System Improvements.

Mayor Jenkins said the system improvement list is in front of them if they would like to review it. It includes a manual electric control for the fill station. It would eliminate the need to find another location if there is a problem with the station. The cost is \$1,555.50. Council Member Nedreberg made a motion to approve the manual electric control for the fill station in the amount of \$1,555.50. Council Member Davis seconded the motion. A roll call vote was taken all in favor motion carried. Mayor Jenkins said if the Council wanted he could have the Full Spectrum Integrator come and meet with the Council.

City Truck Purchase

The item was discussed during the Work Meeting. Council Member Nedreberg made a motion to authorize the Mayor up to \$15,000 to purchase a truck or multiple trucks for city use. Council Member Atherley seconded the motion. A roll call vote was taken all in favor motion carried.

REPORT OF OFFICERS AND COMMITTEES

Recreation Committee.

Council Member Davis said Keagan was hanging the Veterans banners when he noticed the truck had a massive oil leak. The oil is coming from the motor that operates the generator. Member Davis will work on the truck as soon as he can. They can use the truck by following the procedures he showed Keagan and checking the oil each time. He apologized to the Mayor concerning the recording of the Recreation meetings. He thought they were being recorded. He asked Recorder Bigler to find out if it is a requirement. She contacted the city attorney, and he sent over some information. He will make sure they start recording their meetings. He thanked everyone who helped with the Veterans flags at the cemetery. The Committee wants to try and do a walk through of the cemetery and identify any Veterans they don't have on the rolls. He felt the city let everyone down when it came to hanging the banners. Some poles didn't have any banners, and some banners didn't make it through the weekend before they ended up on the ground. Mayor Jenkins already talked to Tyler, and he will get the equipment he needs to hang them properly. He also had to take some of the blame himself for not giving them better directions. We will strive to do better. If Tyler has any questions he can come talk to Council Member Davis. Council Member Nedreberg said a lot of cities have a monument as a place of honor, maybe that is something that could be addressed. The Committee has been discussing this idea. Member Davis is in the process working on a procedure for how to handle vendor information.

Planning Committee.

Council Member Atherley discussed what he had at the Work Meeting. They are working on rewriting Chapter 5 of the Zoning Ordinance. He has sent 11 street projects to Raeleen.

Council Member Charles Davis - Jessica Nielsen came to the podium and spoke about the banners. She upset about the mounts being left at the bottom of some of the poles. Some of the banners were ripped and not hung correctly. She said she purchased very strong wind resistant

banners. Council Member Davis said we have 40 banners and he wants each set of banners to be changed each week. Mayor Jenkins will talk to Tyler and Keagan.

Council Member Kimberly Clements – She met with Steven Hawkins on the OHV grant. Council Member Maxfield will work on the grant.

Council Member Thomas Nedreberg – He said there will be a BBQ June 4th at the Botanical Garden (Young Living Farms). The State Tourism board will be there. He and the Mayor are planning on attending.

Council Member Raeleen Maxfield – She was no longer on Zoom.
