Per- and Polyfluoroalkyl Substances (PFAS) and Biosolids – Wastewater Treatment Plant Challenges : Leland Myers, Director of the Wasatch Front Water Quality Council (WFWQC), and Brandon Heidelberger, Assistant General Manager of the Central Valley Water Reclamation Facility, will share a presentation on recent research and observations regarding Per- and Polyfluoroalkyl Substances (PFAS, also referred to as “forever chemicals”) in biosolids and effluent water from wastewater treatment facilities that discharge into the Jordan River. Staff from the Utah Division of Water Quality may also provide additional background and context.

Additional Background: PFAS chemicals, which are found in both drinking water sources and in waste stream water, are identified as potential health risks for both humans and wildlife. The Utah Water Quality Board has recently initiated rulemaking to study and potentially address impacts.

- b. America 250 – Year of Service Engagements for Stormwater Education and Action : Soren Simonsen, Executive Director, and Rachel Lyn, Communications & Outreach Manager, of the Jordan River Commission, will share updates and upcoming engagements for a program being developed over the coming year to engagement with Jordan River Watershed communities on stormwater education and actions to reduce various stormwater pollutants—chemicals, organic matter, and litter/debris.
