

ORDINANCE 5-2026  
HUNTINGTON CITY

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CERTAIN STATUTORY REFERENCES IN THE HUNTINGTON CITY CODE TO REFLECT CURRENT UTAH CODE CITATIONS AND AMENDING SECTION 9-2-2; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council of Huntington has adopted a municipal code governing the operation of the City; and

WHEREAS, certain sections and statutory reference tables within the Huntington City Code contain outdated references to the Utah Code; and

WHEREAS, the Utah State Legislature has amended and renumbered portions of the Utah Code applicable to municipalities; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds it necessary to update such references to ensure consistency with current state law; and

WHEREAS, the Huntington City Planning and Zoning Commission held a duly noticed public hearing on January 8, 2026, regarding the proposed amendments and forwarded a recommendation of approval to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of Huntington City, Utah, considered and approved the proposed amendments on January 21, 2026; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds it necessary to adopt the amendments by ordinance to ensure proper codification of the Huntington City Code;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of Huntington City, Utah:

SECTION 1. PURPOSE

The purpose of this ordinance is to update outdated statutory references within the Huntington City Code and to amend Section 9-2-2 to ensure consistency with current Utah law.

SECTION 2. AMENDMENT OF STATUTORY REFERENCES TABLE

The “Statutory References for Utah Cities and Towns” tables within the Huntington City Code are hereby amended as follows:

1. Subdivisions – Plats and Subdivisions:
  - The reference to “10-9a-601” is hereby replaced with “10-20-801.”
2. Zoning – Appeal Authority:
  - The reference to “10-9a-701” is hereby replaced with “10-20-1101.”

3. Zoning – Zoning Power of Cities and Towns:

- The reference to “10-9a-501” is hereby replaced with “10-20-501.”

SECTION 3. AMENDMENT OF SECTION 9-2-2

Section 9-2-2, “Terms Defined,” within the Accessory Dwelling Unit (ADU) provisions of the Huntington City Code is hereby amended as follows:

- The reference to “10-9a-530(1)” is hereby replaced with “10-21-303.”

SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY

If any provision of this ordinance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance shall take effect upon passage, approval, and posting as required by law.
