A RESOLUTION TO ADOPT THE 2027 FISCAL YEAR BUDGET

Total Revenue: \$1,192,333.00

Expenditures: General Government - \$294,250

Public Safety - \$116,500.00

Highways and Public Improvements - \$289,400.00

Parks, Recreation and Public Property – \$375,093.00

Debt Service - \$42,090.00

Transfer to Capital - \$75,000.00

Capital Projects Fund: Revenue and Expenses \$208,000.00

Utility Fund: Revenue \$566,600.00, Expense \$625,891.00

Secondary Fund: Revenue \$88,000.00, Expense \$97,000.00

Perpetual Care Fund: Revenue and Expenses \$55,000.00

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, this resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption and replaces any resolution in conflict therewith.
