Subject: 2026 Staff Bonuses

The CWC is projected to have a surplus of over \$100,000 at the end of the fiscal year. This surplus largely consists of unspent Ski Bus Priority Access Program funds (\$30,000) given the very low snow year, and a cancelled contract to further develop the Human Element of the Central Wasatch Dashboard (\$40,000) due to Sandy City cutting their CWC contribution after the budget was passed, and then unexpectedly re-instating full funding after the contract was cancelled to compensate for the budget shortage.

The Executive/Budget/Audit Committee recommends allocating \$35,000 of the CWC's projected FY 2026 budget surplus toward staff bonuses. \$20,000 would be given to Lindsey Nielsen, \$10,000 to Sam Kilpack, and \$5,000 to Will McKay. The reasons for this proposed reallocation are outlined below:

- Due to budgetary constraints during the passage of the FY 2026 budget, CWC staff did not take raises.
- Despite a potential loss of funding from Sandy City next fiscal year, the projected FY 2026 budget surplus is over \$100,000 (a current budget report is attached to this memo).
- Bonuses reflect staff tenure. Lindsey has worked for the CWC since 2018, Sam since 2023, and Will since December 2025.
- There is increased momentum and a potential window to pass the CWNCRRA in the next two years, after which broad jurisdictional support is likely to dwindle and a re-evaluation of the existence and future of the CWC will occur.
