1-Introductions	Chair Lorene Kamalu welcomed attendees and conducted introductions. Meeting access and connectivity improvements were noted.	
2- Dr. Todd Soutor Updates on Davis Behavioral Health services	Dr. Todd Soutor, Director of Intensive Services at Davis Behavioral Health, provided an overview of behavioral health services and partnerships within Davis County. Discussion included coordination with law enforcement, crisis response resources and treatment programs. Discussion focused on the partnership between Davis Behavioral Health and the Clearfield Police Department, including the dedicated mental health officer position. Updates were provided on the 988 Crisis Line, Mobile Crisis Outreach Team (MCOT) and the Davis Behavioral Health Receiving Center. The MCOT currently resolves most crisis calls without law enforcement intervention. Dr. Soutor shared information regarding the development of a 60-bed housing facility for individuals experiencing serious mental illness, anticipated to open in early 2027.	Commissioner Kamalu to coordinate with Chief Bennett to meet Detective Blake Whitehead.
4- Conclusion	Commissioner Kamalu discussed the upcoming UAC Justice Summit and the importance of voting in the upcoming election on June 23 rd .
