

**GARFIELD COUNTY COMMISSION MEETING
JUNE 8, 2026 AT 10:00 A.M.**

Present: Commissioner Leland Pollock, Commissioner David Tebbs, Attorney Barry Huntington, Clerk Camille Moore and Deputy Clerk Kylee Orton.

Commissioner Jerry Taylor was excused.

Commissioner Pollock called the meeting to order and Camille Moore led the pledge of allegiance.

Commissioner Tebbs made a MOTION to adopt the agenda. Seconded by Commissioner Pollock. Motion carried. Voting: Pollock - Aye, Tebbs - Aye

Commissioner Tebbs made a MOTION to approve the minutes of the May 26th. Seconded by Commissioner Pollock. Motion carried. Voting: Pollock - Aye, Tebbs - Aye

BOARD REPORTS

Commissioner Tebbs reported on attending LEPC at Bryce Canyon. He recognized the county volunteers and staff who consistently contribute to the success of county events. He noted that he has a meeting scheduled this week with the Boulder EMTs. He also discussed the county's current fire restrictions and reported that representatives from Ticaboo had contacted him regarding efforts to improve their fire department.

Commissioner Pollock reported receiving a call indicating that Tropic Reservoir is currently out of water, resulting in a lack of water service to the restrooms and showers. He reported that the Sheriff's Office is experiencing a shortage of jail bed space and noted that the County is working with the CIB Board on plans to expand the jail facility. Commissioner Pollock reported that the Forest Service Headquarters is being relocated to Salt Lake City. He gave an update on the Hatch Town Dam.

EMPLOYEE LONGEVITY

Greg Shakespear and Clint Moore were recognized for their 10 years of dedicated service with the Garfield County Road Department.

PUBLIC WORK BUSINESS

Dave Dodds, Public Works Director, provided an update on current projects and activities being completed by the road crew.
